CLAT UG 2025 Syllabus

The five subjects of the CLAT UG 2025 syllabus test some common and some subject-specific skills. While the common skills are reading, critical thinking and analytical skills, the subject-specific skills are different for each subject. Let's explore each subject in depth.

CLAT 2025 Syllabus for English Language and Comprehension

The CLAT English section is primarily a test of a candidate's language skills – reading, comprehension, and grammar. The questions are asked from six to seven passages of around 450 words each. Each passage is followed by a series of multiple-choice type questions. Students have to read the passages and answer the underlying questions accordingly. The passages are drawn from fiction, non-fiction, and journalistic sources such as newspapers and magazines.

Although prior knowledge of law is not required in the CLAT 2025 Legal Reasoning Syllabus, some level of familiarity with the subject and current legal affairs will help the candidates answer questions. In this regard, the consortium mentions that candidates will benefit from general awareness of current legal and moral issues while applying general principles or propositions in various fact scenarios.

Most Questions in CLAT logical reasoning follow a similar paragraph pattern containing statements, arguments and facts. The language and tone of the passages can be tricky with the use of words like “And/Or, Where/There, All/Some” etc. Additionally, this section will have arguments and patterns which candidates will have to use to draw relationships or apply those arguments in different situations.

1. English Language Section

The CLAT English section evaluates your proficiency in English grammar, vocabulary, and comprehension skills. It tests your ability to understand passages and answer questions based on them.

Quick Tips

- **Improve Vocabulary:** Read extensively and make a habit of learning new words daily. Use flashcards or vocabulary apps to memorise synonyms, antonyms, and word meanings.
- **Brush up on Grammar:** Revise essential grammar rules, including tenses, parts of speech, sentence structures, and subject-verb agreement.
- **Practice Comprehension:** Regularly attempt reading comprehension exercises to enhance your reading speed and comprehension abilities.
- **Focus on Cloze Tests:** Cloze tests evaluate your understanding of the context. Practice exercises involving filling in the blanks with appropriate words.
- **Solve Previous Year Papers:** Analyse past year's English Language sections to understand the question patterns and types of questions asked.

How to Attempt Questions for the English Language for CLAT 2025

- The English section of CLAT is generally easy to moderately difficult. Therefore, it is not the level of questions but speed is required to read the long passages.
- Avoid attempting the English section as the first part of the paper. Due to its lengthy nature, it is better to tackle it after completing two other sections or towards the end of the exam. This approach ensures that you allocate sufficient time and focus to sections that might require quicker, more straightforward responses, leaving the more time-consuming English comprehension for later.
- Additionally, not all information stated in the passage is essential for the questions. Therefore first read the questions and then try to find their answers in the passage in the first reading itself.
- Even if you don't have time to read an entire English passage, make sure to read the questions first. This way, you can attempt vocabulary and fill-in-the-blank questions on the spot, as these often don't require a full understanding of the passage.

2. Legal Reasoning Section

CLAT Legal Reasoning assesses your ability to analyse legal principles, identify the relationship between laws, and apply them to specific scenarios.

Quick Tips

- **Understand Legal Concepts:** Read up on fundamental legal concepts, key legal maxims, and landmark judgments to build a strong foundation.
- **Practise Legal Reasoning Questions:** Solve a wide range of legal reasoning questions from previous year's papers and practice books to hone your skills.
- **Analyse Case Scenarios:** Familiarise yourself with various legal case scenarios and practice applying the relevant laws to arrive at logical conclusions.
- **Keep Updated:** Stay updated with current legal developments and amendments to enhance your understanding of contemporary legal issues.

How to Attempt Questions for Legal Reasoning CLAT 2025

- For legal reasoning, read the passage carefully and try to understand the legal principles explained. This principle will help you in answering almost all questions based on that passage.
- While answering the question, identify if the questions are based on the facts and justify your answer without any assumptions. If you are doubtful between two options, always choose the one that combines facts and legal principles and then provide the correct answer.
- Always remember to focus on the legal principles. Leave out any assumptions or personal legal theories before answering.

3. Logical Reasoning Section

CLAT Logical Reasoning evaluates your ability to analyse patterns, arguments, and logical deductions. This section examines your critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

Quick Tips

- **Master Logical Puzzles:** Practice solving puzzles, seating arrangements, and logical sequences to improve your analytical reasoning.
- **Identify Argument Structure:** Understand the structure of arguments in passages and identify premises, assumptions, and conclusions.
- **Strengthen Logical Arguments:** Practice strengthening and weakening arguments to improve your reasoning abilities.
- **Apply Deductive Reasoning:** Practice questions involving syllogisms and conditional statements to strengthen your deductive reasoning skills.

How to Attempt Questions for Logical Reasoning CLAT 2025

- Logical Reasoning is the most gaining section if attempted properly. It consists of 30 questions out of which a student can easily score 25+ marks.

- The logical Reasoning section now mostly consists of critical reasoning, i.e. passage-based questions. This section mostly analyses your arguments, logical patterns and conclusion-drawing skills. It is therefore essential to focus and practice questions of 'Statement and Assumption', 'Statement and Conclusion', 'Statement and Arguments', 'Cause and Effect', etc.
- Now, pay major attention to words like 'not', 'true' and 'false' in the questions. Before answering, understand what has been asked in the question.

4. Quantitative Aptitude Section

CLAT Quantitative Aptitude evaluates your mathematical skills and your ability to solve numerical problems.

Quick Tips

- **Review Mathematical Basics:** Brush up on fundamental concepts of arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and trigonometry.
- **Practice Regularly:** Solve a wide range of quantitative aptitude problems from different topics to enhance your problem-solving speed and accuracy.
- **Memorise Important Formulas:** Create a formula sheet and revise it regularly to recall formulas during the exam.
- **Use Shortcuts:** Learn shortcut methods for calculations to save time during the exam.

How to Attempt Questions for Quantitative Techniques CLAT 2025

- The Quantitative Techniques section has a weightage of 10 to 14 questions in CLAT.
- will include certainty or propositions, graphs, or other textual, pictorial, or diagrammatic representations of numerical data. Quantitative Techniques 4 - 5 numerical questions will follow each topic. Percentage questions will certainly be included in the paper.
- Never leave this section considering your weak point. This is the scoring section and at times consists of very simple questions. At the same time, there is only one correct answer here, making it easier to achieve high accuracy.
- Develop the skill to identify which questions in the Quantitative Techniques section should be skipped. Not all questions are worth spending time on and recognizing the more complex or time-consuming ones allows you to focus on those that you can solve more efficiently, thereby maximizing your overall score.

5. General Knowledge/Current Affairs Section

General Knowledge/Current Affairs assesses your awareness of current events and general knowledge.

Quick Tips

- **Stay Updated:** Regularly read newspapers, magazines, and reliable online sources to keep abreast of current affairs.

- **Make Notes:** Make concise notes of important events, dates, and facts to facilitate quick revision.
- **Take Quizzes:** Participate in quizzes and online tests to assess your knowledge and retention of current affairs.
- **Focus on Legal and Constitutional Matters:** Pay special attention to legal and constitutional developments, as they are crucial for CLAT.

How to Attempt Questions for Current Affairs including GK for CLAT 2025

- For the General Knowledge section, passages are not generally important. If you have a regular habit of reading newspapers, you can answer the general knowledge questions without any reference to the passage.
- If you are not aware of the entire topic that the passage is based upon, then prefer reading the passage as the answers might be provided in the passage itself. This happened in CLAT 2024.
- The Current Affairs section is the rank provider. Make sure to attend it in the first or second sequence so that you do not end up losing marks here.

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How to Attempt CLAT UG 2025 Questions

Attempting questions in the CLAT exam efficiently can greatly impact your overall performance. Here's a strategy to help you approach the exam confidently:

01. Understand the Structure of the Exam

- Familiarize yourself with the exam format.
- CLAT consists of sections like English Language, Current Affairs, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Techniques.

02. Time Management

- Allocate time to each section based on your strengths and weaknesses.

- Be cautious with guesses; CLAT has a negative marking system (0.25 marks are deducted for each wrong answer).

06. Keep Track of Time

- Regularly check the clock to manage your pace.
- Avoid spending too much time on any single question.

07. Review Marked Questions

If you have time after answering all the questions, review the ones you were unsure about or skipped.

Rethink them with a fresh perspective or with insights you might have gained while solving other questions.

08. Stay Calm and Composed

Keep your cool throughout the exam. Anxiety can cloud judgment and affect performance. Take deep breaths if you start feeling overwhelmed.

09. Practice with Mock Tests

CLAT UG Question Paper Analysis (2020-2024)

CLAT Exam Analysis 2020

CLAT 2020 was conducted in a CBT (Computer Based Test) methodology format and was the 1st exam to be conducted in a 150-mark format with a new exam structure. It has 150 questions across 5 areas including English Language, Current Affairs, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning and Quantitative Techniques. The exam was overall moderately difficult with some sections having higher difficulty levels. Compared to earlier exam patterns and papers till 2019, the 2020 paper was lengthy which posed a time management struggle for the students. The Logical Reasoning section was manageable while the Legal Reasoning section had a fair share of lengthy questions. The Current Affairs section and Quantitative Techniques section were on the moderate side. Overall, the 2020 exam being the first paper in the new pattern taught students to crack the future exams. It offered several insights and lessons for future aspirants.

CLAT 2024 featured a modified exam pattern with 120 questions, and the changed paper pattern threw clouds of doubt; nonetheless, contrary to everyone's predictions, the CLAT 2024 paper was easy to moderate. 105+ is a respectable number of tries, and 90+ is a decent mark for the top three national law schools.

The Consortium of National Law Universities recently announced significant adjustments to the CLAT 2024 exam pattern. These modifications affect the undergraduate (UG) test. The UG exam's total number of questions has been lowered from 150 to 120. The exam lasts two hours.
