English Language

The English Language portion assesses your knowledge of vocabulary, grammar, and understanding of the language. It evaluates how well you can understand texts and answer questions based on that understanding.

Suggestions:

How To Prepare For SLAT Writing Ability Test (WAT)

Candidates shortlisted after the [Symbiosis Law Admission](#) Test appeared for the SLAT Writing Ability Test along with the SA Personal Interview (PI). The SLAT WAT was held in online mode. The Symbiosis International (Deemed) University notifies the WAT/PI dates for the [SLAT selection process](#) on its official website - set-test.org after the declaration of the SLAT result. The university conducts SLAT in two phases.

SLAT Writing Ability Test Syllabus

The SLAT WAT is designed to test the candidate's writing ability and the ability to argue and reason logically. The syllabus of the SLAT Writing Ability Test consists of writing essays on the given topics within the given time frame. Usually, candidates are given two topics and have to choose one essay out of the two options.

How to Prepare for the SLAT Writing Ability Test?

As mentioned above, SLAT WAT is descriptive which tests the candidate's writing skills and ability to form logical arguments. A candidate's preparation for SLAT WAT must focus on developing these skills.

Tips to Write a Good Essay during SLAT WAT

- Divide the essay into appropriate paragraphs to improve readability and presentation.
- 4-5 paragraphs would be enough for SLAT WAT.
- Understand the given topic properly first before beginning to write.
- Plan out and divide the essay into appropriate parts such as intro, body and conclusion.

- Ensure there is coherence and continuity in the writing
- Refrain from using fancy words just for the sake of using them. Prioritise simplicity and readability.
- Provide informative content on the subject asked in the question. Displaying subject expertise on the essay topic will fetch more marks.

Additional Preparation Tips for SLAT WAT

- Awareness about current affairs: Aspiring candidates must develop good awareness about the latest happenings in various fields such as politics, economy, sports and others. This will ensure there is no dearth of content when writing the essay.
- Develop a reading habit: A regular reading habit not only improves knowledge but will also help in improving reading and comprehension skills, which are very important in law entrance exams.
- Make Notes: If one comes across some important points during the course of one's reading, they should note down the points. In this way, one can always go back to them to reinforce one's grasp and understanding on a particular subject.
- Work on improving vocabulary and Grammar: A good command over English with a wide vocabulary will enable the candidate to put down his or her thoughts on paper in a better way. One can refer to books on English grammar, flash cards and subscribe to a daily newspaper to improve one's language skills.
- Practise Writing/Typing: Candidates must practise for SLAT WAT by writing on a piece of paper or typing on a computer screen on any given topic. Repeated writing practice will improve writing/typing speed and condition the mind for SLAT WAT.

How To Prepare for SLAT PI (Personal Interview)

The [SLAT selection process](#) consists of the exam and the personal interview. The [SLAT WAT](#) has been done away with. SLAT PI carries 30 marks while the marks obtained in [SLAT 2024](#) would be scaled to 70 marks. The total mark in the SLAT selection process is 100 marks. It must be noted that the SLAT PI round will be conducted separately for each of the [four Symbiosis Law Schools](#).

What is SLAT PI?

SLAT PI is a personal interview round conducted by the [Symbiosis International \(Deemed\) University](#) for candidates shortlisted after the exam for admission into [BA LLB](#) and [BBA LLB](#) programmes of the Symbiosis Law Schools. The SLAT PI is conducted in online remote proctored mode.

Steps in SLAT PI Round

The SLAT PI round will be held in remote proctored mode for the shortlisted candidates. Each SLS will conduct its own SLAT PI. Given below are the important steps involved in the SLAT PI round-

- Publication of list of shortlisted candidates and interview schedule on the institute's website based on the marks obtained in the entrance exam.
- Uploading of CV by the students as instructed by the university
- A system readiness check was conducted to test the suitability of the candidate's computer system
- Appearing for the interview
- Publication of final merit list

Declaration to be submitted by the Candidate

At the time of appearing for the SLAT PI round, the candidate has to sign and submit an important declaration to the university. The SLAT PI undertaking contains certain rules and instructions that the candidate has to follow for the SLAT PI round. Failing to comply with the instructions can lead to disqualification of the candidate. Given below is a sample copy of the undertaking.

Things tested in SLAT PI

Preparation for SLAT PI requires an understanding of the things that will be tested in the SLAT personal interview. The primary focus of the SLAT interview is on personality and communication skills, and other traits. The interview will also assess the basic legal knowledge of the candidate, but a deeper understanding of law may not be required.

Given below is a list of skills and traits that are assessed in the interview round -

- Candidate's personality and individual characteristics
- Communication skills of the candidate
- Candidate's aptitude/suitability to study law
- Other Interests and hobbies of the candidate

SLAT PI Questions

Given below is a list of SLAT personal interview questions that can be asked in the SLAT PI round. Through these questions, the interviewer seeks to test the traits that have been listed earlier in the article. The SLAT PI questions and possible responses are given below

Question: Tell me about yourself

Here candidates can talk briefly about their educational background, interests, family and any significant achievement that is relevant to the context. The interviewer may ask some follow-up questions depending on what the candidate says.

Question: Why did you choose to study law?

Candidates must talk about their underlying motivation which prompted them to take up legal studies. They can also connect their interests with their chosen vocation if they are in alignment.

Question: Why did you choose Symbiosis?

Here candidates can talk about the university and its place in the education arena. They can also

speak about any specific reasons for choosing Symbiosis.

Question: What are your career goals?

This question seeks to understand where the candidate sees himself or herself in a few years from now as well as in the long term.

Question: Tell me about (any topic)

The interviewer will try to check the candidate's knowledge on a certain topic or current event.

PI Interview Questions: Important Topics

- Contempt of court any recent judgment on this
- Important political personalities
- Important personalities in law such as CJI, judges, female judges, lawyers.
- Questions on one's area of interest in law such as criminal law, taxation law

- Total strength of judges in SC and the ratio of females
- Name the female judges of SC
- Who is the first CJ of MP
- Top criminal lawyers?
- Any act regarding criminal law?

SLAT PI Round Preparation Tips

Given below are a few preparation tips for the SLAT PI round:

- Study the possible questions that can be asked in SLAT PI beforehand which will make sure there will not be any surprises during the interview.
- Go through the CV carefully as questions may be asked based on the information contained in it.
- Read up on current topics and stay up to date with the news.
- Examine the current topics from a legal perspective and determine its legal validity.
- Work on improving communication skills and speaking fluently.
- Practise active listening to understand the questions in the same way as intended by the interviewer.
- Be yourself and don't try to overdo anything.

How to prepare a CV for SLAT PI?

Uploading the CV is an important step in the SLAT PI process. The SLAT PI CV is uploaded online as instructed by the university before the interview. The SLAT personal interview questions could be asked based on the CV.

Information to be provided in SLAT PI CV

The CV for SLAT PI requires the candidate to provide the following information:

- Candidate's name
- SLAT registration number
- Brief information of CV
- Academic details and achievements
- Extra-curricular details and achievements
- Career goals
- Additional qualification
- Reason for selecting the desired law programme (BA LLB / BBA LLB)
- Any other additional information

Tips to prepare SLAT PI CV

- Prepare the CV as per the format prescribed by the university
- Ensure there are no grammatical and spelling errors.
- Be honest while filling up the information.
- Focus on the underlying motivation for your choice to study law and write the answers.
