NEET PG



The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, New Delhi (NBEMS) conducts the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test Postgraduate, [NEET PG](#) for admission to Doctor of Medicine ([MD](#)), Master of Surgery ([MS](#)) and Postgraduate Diploma courses. A detailed guide to the NEET PG entrance exam is provided below.

Who can appear for NEET PG?

Candidates must meet the required [NEET PG eligibility criteria](#) before filling out the application form. The essential requirements for NEET PG eligibility criteria are listed below.

- Candidates are required to possess an MBBS degree or Provisional MBBS Pass Certificate recognised by the Indian Medical Council Act 1956.
- Aspirants must have MBBS qualification registration (permanent/provisional) issued by the Medical Council of India (MCI) or State Medical Council (SMC).
- Candidates must complete their one-year internship.
- There is no NEET PG age limit

Note: The internship completion date can be checked from the information bulletin of the current year.

How to fill NEET PG application form?

The NEET PG application form involves several steps that aspirants must follow. Candidates must fill out their NEET PG application form before the last date to avoid any kind of errors or technical issues in the last time. Candidates are advised to read the NEET PG official information brochure available on nbe.edu.in. Aspirants will be able to access the [NEET PG application form](#) at nbe.edu.in.

Steps to fill out the application form for NEET PG

- Visit nbe.edu.in, click on the NEET PG tab and register with a valid phone number and email address.
- Fill out the NEET PG application form
- Choose NEET PG exam city
- Upload scanned images
- Pay the fee as per your category
- Take a printout of the confirmation page

Documents required for NEET PG application form

- A valid email ID and mobile number
- Educational details (MBBS, exam status, state, university details, state of Class 10 and 12)
- Internship details (status of internship, start and completed date of the internship, total days of internship)
- Scanned images of photograph, signature and left-thumb impression
- Credit card/Debit card, Net Banking and UPI payment details

NEET PG application fee

All candidates need to pay the NEET PG application fee to successfully submit their application form. The NEET PG application fee is non-refundable and can be paid online.

NEET PG admit card

NBE issues the [NEET PG admit card](#) to the successfully registered candidates. The NEET PG admit card can be downloaded from nbe.edu.in using their login ID and password. After downloading the admit card, the aspirants must fix a recent passport-size photograph on the space provided on the NEET PG admit card. It is an important document and without an admit card of NEET PG, no candidate will not be allowed to appear for the test.

What is NEET PG exam pattern?

There will be a sectional timing for each section in NEET PG. The brief overview of the NEET PG exam pattern can be checked below.

What is NEET PG syllabus?

The National Board of Examinations (NBE) prepares the syllabus for NEET PG. The NEET PG syllabus includes subject-wise topics and is prepared based on Pre-Clinical, Clinical, and Para-Clinical subjects from the MBBS curriculum. Aspirants must study the entire [NEET PG syllabus](#) to ace the exam. The syllabus of NEET PG consists of topics/subjects studied in the MBBS course degrees. The summary of the subjects is mentioned below.

Where to check NEET PG result?

The [NEET PG result](#) is declared by NBE at nbe.edu.in in the form of a merit list. The merit list of NEET PG will mention the roll number, marks obtained, All India Rank (AIR), candidate name and other details. The result of NEET PG is valid for one academic year only. To download the scorecard of NEET PG, aspirants need to enter their user ID and password.

About NEET PG counselling

The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) conducts the [NEET PG counselling](#) for 50% of All India Quota (AIQ), and 100% deemed and central universities, ESIC, and AFMS seats, the state counselling authorities conduct counselling for the remaining 50% of state quota seats. The authority conducts several rounds of All India Quota counselling for NEET PG qualified candidates. Candidates will have to register, pay fees, and fill in choices of courses and colleges.
