About TS LAWCET



Introduction

The [Telangana State Law Common Entrance Test](#), organised by Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE) is a state level law entrance exam for admissions to undergraduate law programmes including three-year and five-year integrated LLB of various colleges in the state of Telangana. There are approximately 3,597 seats available for the [3-year LLB programme](#) and around 1,580 seats available for the [5-year LLB](#) programmes.

[TS LAW CET](#) is conducted by [Osmania University](#) on behalf of TSCHE in online mode. The exam is held at designated test centres in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

This ebook compiled and designed by Careers360 provides an overview of the law entrance exam including eligibility, syllabus and paper pattern besides the seat availability and the admission process.



Eligibility

The [TS LAW CET eligibility criteria](#) includes conditions regarding the minimum educational qualification, minimum passing marks and age limit. The details are given below.

Academic Qualification

- **5-Year Integrated Law programmes** : You need to have qualified 10+2 or equivalent exam securing at least 45% marks if belonging to the general category, 42% if belonging to OBC category and 40% if you belong to SC/ST categories
- **3-Year LLB programmes** : You must hold a Graduation degree (10+2+3 pattern) securing a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate of the qualifying subjects. A relaxation of 5% marks is granted for those belonging to SC/ST categories i.e., you need to have secured 40% marks in aggregate of the subjects. OBC candidates must score a minimum of 42% passing marks.

Age Limit

There is no cap on age limit in order to appear for the TS LAW CET exam.

Other conditions for TS LAW CET

The candidates who are appearing in the qualifying exam (both 10+2 and degree level) are also eligible to appear, provided they satisfy the minimum marks required for the qualifying exam. Those candidates who have secured less than 45% marks in graduation need to provide any additional graduate or postgraduate degree with 45% marks which they possess as a qualifying degree.



TS LAW CET Application Process

Candidates who wish to appear for the TS LAW CET exam are required to fill the [TS LAW CET application form](#) online on the official website. They must also pay the required fees. After paying the required fees, candidates are able to fill out the application form.

It must be noted that the application fee payment can be made through credit card, debit card, net banking or through TS/AP online centres.

How to Fill TS LAW CET Application Form?

- Visit the official website - lawcet.tsche.ac.in.
- Click on the registration link.
- Fill out the name, date of birth, mobile number, e-mail id, qualifying examination, preferred course, and other relevant information.
- Select up to three [TS LAW CET exam centres](#) in order of preference
- Upload scanned copy of latest photograph and signature as per the prescribed format and size.
- Submit and download the application form for future reference.

Documents Required

- Receipt form from TS/AP online centre
- Hall ticket of qualifying exam
- Class 10th certificate or birth proof
- Aadhar card
- Transfer Certificate (TC)
- Study or residence certificate for proof of local status
- Income certificate issued by MRO or competent authority
- Caste certificate issued by MRO or any competent authority and application number of the caste certificate (in case of SC/ST only)
- NCC, PH, CAP certificate issued by a competent authority if applicable
- Passport size photograph and signature
- Credit/debit cards for online payment

TS LAW CET Exam Pattern

The [exam pattern of TS LAW CET](#) tests the candidates on general knowledge, legal aptitude, and mental ability. The exam is conducted once a year in online mode.

TS LAW CET Syllabus

The [TS LAW CET syllabus](#) includes three sections testing the candidates on GK, current affairs and legal aptitude. The details are given below.

General Knowledge and Mental Ability

The questions in this section will be based on general awareness and brainstorming. Most of the questions will be of generic standard. Also it may include questions based on English Grammar and Comprehensions to test basic knowledge of reading and writing skills of the candidate required for the LLB programmes.

Current Affairs

This section will include questions from the latest happenings of national and international level. This section will test the universal development awareness in candidates.

Aptitude for Study of Law

The section will be based on elementary knowledge of basic principles of Law and Constitution of India only. In order to test your interest towards the LL.B programmes, it shall have questions on some of the commonly used legal terms.



TS LAW CET Timeline

TSCHE opens the TS LAW CET application form tentatively in the second week of March. Osmania University issues hall tickets in online mode a few weeks before the exam. The hall ticket can be downloaded by providing the application number and date of birth.

The exam is conducted in the first week of June in online mode. The results for TS LAW CET are announced tentatively one month after the exam.

The TS LAW CET counselling for three-year and five-year integrated LLB admissions begins tentatively a month after the declaration of the results. The counselling is conducted in an online centralised manner.



TS LAW CET Admission Counselling

Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE) conducts the [TS LAW CET counselling](#) after the declaration of result. Candidates who are eligible for ranking would be required to register for the counselling process online.

The shortlisted candidates would be required to fill their choices and upload the required documents and obtain seat allotment. After obtaining the seat allotment the candidate must report to the college and complete the rest of the admission formalities such as payment of admission and tuition fees.

Steps in TS LAW CET Counselling Process

- Register online for the counselling process by visiting the official website -lawcet.tsche.ac.in.
- Make the counselling registration fee payment
- Upload the scanned copy of required documents
- Submit the web options for the preferred colleges
- Publication of seat allotment by the authorities
- Reporting at the college
