Delhi University BA LLB Admission 2024

All You Need to Know



Introduction

Delhi University is offering 5-year integrated law programmes from the academic year 2023-24 onwards. The DU 5-year LLB courses include [BA LLB \(Hons.\)](#) and [BBA LLB \(Hons.\)](#). The DU 5-year LLB admissions are done on the basis of the [Common Law Admission Test](#). Therefore any candidate aspiring to participate in DU 5-year LLB admission must first appear for CLAT.

Faculty of Law, Delhi University is offering the [5-year LLB programmes](#) at Kanad Bhawan on the university campus. DU BA LLB and DU BBA LLB each have a seat intake of 60 seats. DU 5-year LLB Admission Process

The 5-year LLB admission process at [Delhi University](#) involves many steps. It starts with the candidate appearing for CLAT and finally ends with the candidate obtaining seat allotment at the university. Given below is a snapshot of the [DU BA LLB](#) admission process.

Step 1: Appear in CLAT and obtain a valid score and rank

Step 2: Meet the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed by the university

Step 3: Register at the university admission portal

Step 4: Publication of merit list by the university

Step 5. Seat acceptance, payment of university fees and submission of documents



DU 5-year LLB Eligibility Criteria

Before applying for Delhi University's 5-year LLB admission, candidates must ensure they fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria stipulated by the university. The admission would be solely conducted based on scores obtained in the Common Law Admission Test. Given below are the 5-year eligibility criteria prescribed by Delhi University.

DU BA LLB Eligibility Criteria

Particulars	Details
Minimum Educational Qualification	10+2 or equivalent
Minimum passing marks	45% marks for UR/ EWS/ OBC-NCL category 40% marks for SC/ST category
Entrance exam	Valid CLAT score
Age limit	No age limit



DU 5-year LLB Application Form

After appearing for [CLAT](#) and obtaining a valid score, a candidate has to separately apply at the admission portal of Delhi University. The DU 5-year LLB application is released only in online mode. The steps to complete the DU 5-year LLB Application are given below -

- Visit the admission portal of Delhi University
- Register at the portal to obtain login credentials
- Sign in with the user ID and password
- Fill the particulars in the application form that include personal details, education qualification, course preference and address details
- Submit the application form
- Pay the application fee to complete the registration

Documents Required for DU 5-year LLB Application

- Class 10th certificate
- Class 12th mark sheet and certificate
- CLAT admit card.
- CLAT scorecard
- Caste certificate (if applicable)
- Income certificate (if applicable)
- Disability certificate (if applicable)

DU 5-year LLB Merit List and Counselling

Delhi University will publish the merit list for DU 5-year LLB based on the candidate's score in CLAT. The merit list is provisional as the candidates are required to complete other admission formalities to finalise their admission. The merit list would be published in multiple rounds.

After the publication of the merit list, Delhi University will notify the DU 5-year LLB counselling schedule on its official website. The counselling rounds are held after the publication of each merit list. Given below are the steps involved in the counselling process

- Candidates must choose either the upgrade or freeze option.
- The candidates must then “accept” the seat through their login before the stipulated deadline.
- The faculty of Law would then verify and approve the online applications.
- After obtaining approval, the candidates must pay the fees prescribed by the university within the stipulated deadline
- Candidates who had chosen to upgrade in an earlier round are not required to do any of the above as they would have done it in the earlier round.



DU 5-year LLB Cut Off

Since DU 5-year LLB admissions are done on the basis of CLAT, it's important to understand the trends in [CLAT cut-off](#) to make sense of trends in DU BA LLB cut off.

For admission in NLUs, the cut off for general category usually goes up to 2500-3000 rank. Going by that, the expected cut-off for DU 5-year LLB is likely to be below 4500 rank. Delhi University may also increase its seat intake which can further lower the cut off.



DU 5-year LLB Reservation and Seat Matrix

Delhi University offers 60 seats each for its BA LLB (Hons.) and BBA LLB (Hons.) programmes. The category-wise DU 5-year LLB seat matrix is given below.
