

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# INTRODUCTION

NCHM JEE is a national-level exam conducted once a year by National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission to undergraduate courses in hospitality. Earlier it was conducted by National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMT). National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (Society) was set up in the year 1982 by the Government of India as an autonomous body for coordinated growth and development of hospitality management education in the country. The Council regulates academics in the field of hospitality education & training that is imparted at the 21 Central Government Institutes of Hotel Management, 30 State Government IHMs offering Degree level programme; 2 PPP run SIHMs, 1 Public sector Institute, and 24 private Institutes that function in different parts of the country.

Students can fill NCHM JEE online application form from second week of February onwards. The exam will be conducted on computer-based mode in second week of May. Candidates who are appearing for NCHM JEE can take admission in two undergraduate courses - B. Sc. in Hospitality & Hotel Administration (Generic or Specialization).

Aspirants can submit the application form along with the fee till last week of March in online mode. NCHM JEE admit card is available from first week of May onwards. After the exam, the authorities issue the response sheet. National Council of Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMCT) has announced that the NCHM JEE will be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) from. The result of NCHM JEE is declared in first week of June. The counselling process begin from first week of June during which candidates have to fill in their choices and lock it. There are 78 participating institutes that offer candidates on the basis of their performance in NCHM JEE.



## WHAT'S NEW IN NCHM JEE

- NCHMJEE will be conducted for the by National Testing Agency.
- The entrance exam will be conducted in computer-based mode.
- There is no age limit for NCHMCT JEE exam as per the New Education Policy.
- The participating institutions increased to 78, out of which 21 Central Institutes of Hotel Management, 30 State Government Institutes of Hotel Management, 01 Public Sector Undertaking, 2 PPP runs SIHMs and 24 Private Institutes of Hotel Management.
- Exam centres for NCHMCT are conducted in 109 cities.
- There has been a change in the marking scheme. Previously 1 mark was awarded for every correct answer and 0.25 mark was deducted for every wrong answer. From, candidates will be given 4 marks for every correct answer and 1 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer.

## NCHM JEE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility criteria of NCHM JEE mentions the academic details, age limit and the information related to qualifying exam that candidates must meet.

**NCHM JEE Age Limit-** As per NCHM JEE eligibility criteria, there is no age restriction for students who are applying for NCHM JEE exam as per new education policy.

### **Qualifying Exams–**

Candidates who will be appearing in class 12 exam in the year of admission, they can also take NCHM JEE entrance exam. However, such candidates will have to submit the proof that they have passed the qualifying exam by last week of September or else their provisional admission will be cancelled.

Candidates must have passed their 10+2 or equivalent exam. Candidates must have English as one of their subjects. Candidates must have passed in English in their 10+2.

### **Physical Fitness–**

As per NCHM JEE eligibility criteria, candidates have to provide a physical fitness certificate from a recognized medical practitioner in a prescribed format..



## NCHM JEE APPLICATION FORM

NCHM JEE application form is available from the second week of February. Candidates belonging to the General and OBC category, they have to pay Rs.1000 as application fee, for the General - EWS category students need to pay Rs. 700. While those belonging to SC, ST, PwD and transgender categories have to pay Rs.450. The last date for the submission of the form is the last week of March in online mode. The fees for registration can be paid through debit and credit card till last week of March (till 11:50 p.m)

### **Steps to fill NCHM JEE Application Form**

Candidates will have to follow the steps that are mentioned below while filling the NCHM application form:

- Click on the official link to fill the form.
- Register on the online application form and note down the system generated application number after submission of the necessary details in the NCHM JEE application form.
- Re-login and fill the complete application form
- Upload scanned image of signature and photograph as per the dimensions specified.
- Pay the fee for the NCHM JEE application form before registering
- After filling in all the information, click on the submit button.
- Take a printout of the application form for NCHM JEE and keep it safe for future reference.

## NCHM JEE ADMIT CARD

The admit card of NCHM JEE is released in the first week of May. Candidates can download NCHM JEE admit card by entering the requisite credentials. The authorities will not send NCHM JEE admit card by post.

After downloading the admit card, candidates must check all the details and if there is any mistake, they must bring it to the notice of the authorities concerned and get it rectified at the earliest.

At the time of the entrance test, candidates have to bring with them self-attested copy of the NCHM JEE admit card and have to deposit it to the invigilator after signing it. NCHM JEE admit card is an important document that contains important information such as name, roll number of candidate, along with date, time and address of the test centre.

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## NCHM JEE EXAM CENTRES

Candidates can go through the list of NCHM JEE exam centres released by National Testing Agency. At the time of filling the application form, candidates can select the city where they wish to take the exam. The list of cities where NCHM JEE is held are given below in the table:

## NCHM JEE SYLLABUS

The syllabus of NCHM JEE includes all the topics and subjects from which the questions are asked in the entrance exam. They can assess which topics consume more time and which take less time during the course of their preparation. Students will also get to know their weak areas and work on them accordingly. With the help of NCHM JEE syllabus, candidates can plan their time table for the entrance exam and religiously follow it. Not only this, the syllabus of NCHM JEE helps students to identify which topics hold more weightage in the exam and which are not that essential. To be precise, exam takers must have the syllabus at their fingertips to know the scoring areas in the entrance exam.

## NCHM JEE SAMPLE PAPERS

Candidates can download NCHM JEE sample papers and use them for practising for the entrance exam. With the help of NCHM JEE sample papers, candidates get to know the exam pattern, what are the type of questions that are asked, marking scheme and what is the difficulty level of the entrance exam. By solving the sample paper of NCHM JEE, students also come to know about the areas where improvement is needed. In addition to it, students can also be aware of the important, the moderately important and the topics that hold less weightage by practising NCHM JEE sample papers. Also, candidates can improve their speed and learn to manage the time, which plays a crucial role when taking any exam. The duration of the entrance test is three hours and total marks allotted to the questions is 100. The types of questions asked in the exam is objective and based in computer-based mode. NCHM JEE is conducted in English and Hindi except English language section.

Besides practising the sample paper, students should also follow the right preparation tips to score well in NCHM JEE entrance test. With the help of the right preparation strategy, exam takers also come to know about the study material and books they need to follow to prepare for the exam.

## NCHM JEE ANSWER KEY

National Testing Agency issues the response sheet soon after the NCHM JEE in online mode. Candidates can go through the NCHM JEE answer key and challenge it within the stipulated time. While challenging the answer key, candidates have to pay Rs 1000 per question. By using the NCHM JEE answer key, candidates can calculate their probable score before the announcement of the result by the authority. It is to be noted that students have to follow the official marking scheme for calculation purpose.

### How to Download NCHM JEE Answer key?

The authorities release the answer key of NCHM JEE. Candidates can follow the given below steps to have access to NCHM JEE answer key.

- Click on the link to download answer key.
- Enter the login credentials.
- NCHM JEE answer key appears on the screen.
- Download the answer key.

Students can calculate their score by matching the responses that are given in it. This will give them an idea about the probable marks they would score in NCHM JEE. If candidates feel that there is any mistake in the NCHM JEE answer key, they can challenge it along with adequate proof. The decision of the authorities will be final pertaining to the comments made by candidates.

## NCHM JEE RESULTS

The result of NCHM JEE is declared in second week of May. Candidates can check NCHM JEE result in online mode. NCHM JEE result is announced in the form of merit list. The result of NCHM JEE also consist of scores of candidates. Students will be shortlisted based on the minimum qualifying marks criteria set by National Testing Agency. There are 11995 seats are allotted across 78 participating hotel management institutes, out of which 21 is central institutes, 2 PPP runs SIHMs, 30 is state government institutes, 24 is private institutes and 1 is public sector undertaking. Students must note that the admission to the hotel management programme will be solely based on merit basis.

### **How to Check NCHM JEE Result?**

Students can check the steps below to check the result of NCHM JEE result.

- Click on the result tab
- Enter login credentials, such as roll number, application number, date of birth and security pin.
- Click on 'Submit' tab to check NCHM JEE result.

## NCHM JEE CUTOFF

NCHM JEE cutoff is the minimum marks that candidates belonging to different categories have to score to be eligible for admission. Some of the important parameters that are taken into account while determining the NCHM JEE cutoff are the difficulty level of the entrance exam, total number of candidates who appeared for the entrance test, past years' cutoff trend and total number of available seats. There are 11965 seats offered for admission to undergraduate hotel management programme on the basis of candidate's performance in the entrance test. The opening and closing rank for students belonging to different categories are announced by NTA for the participating institutes. Aspirants can check the previous years' cutoff to know the trends of closing ranks for the different institutes.

## NCHM JEE SELECTION PROCESS

As part of NCHM JEE selection process, candidates are shortlisted on the basis of the rank they secure. It is a two-step process where candidates are shortlisted first based on their NCHM JEE performance and the shortlisted ones appear for the selection procedure of NCHM JEE. The merit list for NCHM JEE is prepared on the basis of the rank secured by candidates. Candidates who score more marks are placed high on the rank list. The selection process of NCHM JEE starts after the announcement of NCHM JEE result. After the declaration of the result, NTA releases the cutoff for all the categories with respect to the participating institutes that accept score of NCHM JEE entrance test. NCHM JEE is conducted in second week of May in computer based mode for admission to undergraduate programme in hospitality sector.

## NCHM JEE COUNSELLING

NCHM JEE counselling is conducted by NTA from first week of June. There are at least three rounds of NCHM JEE counselling that take place, which is solely based on merit basis for admission to 11965 seats. The first, second and third rounds of NCHM JEE counselling take place in the first, third and last week of June, respectively. The counselling of NCHM JEE includes checking candidates' eligibility, document verification, depositing counselling and first-semester fee, along with choosing institutes available during NCHM JEE counselling. A total of 58 participating institutes offer admission to candidates based on their performance in the entrance test. Candidates have to follow the steps that are given below at the time of counselling and seat allotment.

- Online registration for NCHM JEE counselling
- Choice filling and locking
- Seat allotment in online mode
- Reporting to the institute which has been allotted to the candidates
- Payment of admission fees at the allotted institute
- Withdrawal of seat
- Refund of admission fee in accordance with rules and regulations
- Spot round counselling for NCHM JEE

### **NCHM JEE Counselling: Important Instructions**

- Qualified candidates should give maximum number of choices after evaluating all the institutes.
- If a candidate fails to submit the 10+2 marksheet or its equivalents at the time of counselling/admission/latest by last week of September, the Institute will cancel their admission.
- Candidates have to deposit a copy of duly attested admit card during the counselling procedure of NCHM JEE.

## NCHM JEE SEAT ALLOTMENT

After the counselling process is over wherein candidates have filled and locked their choices, the NCHM JEE seat allotment takes place. The result for NCHM JEE seat allotment for the first round is announced in first week of June. Allotment of seat takes place on the basis of the rank secured by the candidates and the choice of the institute filled by them. National Testing Agency conducts counselling in three rounds and the process for seat allotment begins from the first week of June onwards. Qualified candidates are called for the seat allotment process based on the merit. Candidates must attend the seat allotment process on the stipulated time mentioned on the call letter.

Qualified candidates of NCHM JEE have to bring their original as well as photocopy of documents, which include mark sheet of class 12, class 10 qualifying examination certificate, date of birth certificate, reserved category certificate and medical certificate. Seat allocation will be done according to the reservation criteria.

## NCHM JEE RESERVATION CRITERIA

Certain percentage of seats are reserved for candidates who belong to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, OBC category, and General economic weaker sections at the participating institutes. The participating institutes of NCHM JEE are those colleges that offer admission to qualified students in the entrance exam. National Test Agency (NTA), the exam conducting body decides the reservation criteria for NCHM JEE. Candidates belonging to SC, ST and candidates belonging to the Person with Disability (PwD) category are eligible for NCHM JEE reservation and are privileged with certain advantages with respect to seat allocation, qualifying exam scores, entrance exam scores and age limit over non-reserved category categories. Candidates coming under NCHM JEE reservation criteria have to produce the necessary documents as proof of their reservation.
