

The CUET Legal Studies 2024 exam was of easy to moderate difficulty level. The questions were mostly direct questions. There were questions from rearrangement, passages, situation-based questions, match the following type of questions. In the Judiciary section, questions from Tribunals and Jurisdictions were asked. Furthermore, there were questions from crime/contracts, property law (passage-based), Constitution Articles 21, 48A, LSA Act (Amednment) 2002, legal aid eligibility, ICJ, International Law etc. There were no questions from Legal Maxims and Assertion/Reason.
