# VITLEE 2025 SYLLABUS

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The Vellore Institute of Technology Law Entrance Examination (VITLEE) is designed to assess candidates' aptitude and knowledge across five key sections. Below is a detailed breakdown of each section's syllabus:

## VITLEE English Language Section (20 Questions)

This section tests your grasp of the English language and your ability to comprehend and analyse written information.

- **Comprehension Passages**

- **Antonyms and Synonyms**

  - Subject-verb agreement
  - Tense usage (past, present, future)
  - Sentence structure and correction
  - Conjunctions (e.g., and, but, although)
  - Prepositions and articles

## VITLEE General Knowledge and Current Affairs Section (20 Questions)

This section gauges your awareness of the world around you—both past and present.

- **Arts:** Includes Indian classical and contemporary art, famous artists, cultural heritage, festivals, and architecture.
- **Science:** Basic scientific concepts from physics, chemistry, biology, and recent innovations or discoveries.
- **Law:** Awareness of Indian legal system basics, Indian Constitution highlights, landmark judgments, fundamental rights and duties, and recent legal developments.
- **Sports:** Major sports events (like the Olympics and World Cups), current winners, records, and famous sports personalities.
- **India:** History, geography, economy, important policies and schemes, Indian political system, and cultural facts.
- **International Affairs:** Key events on the global stage—international relations, world organizations (UN, WHO, WTO), global summits, and recent geopolitical events.

## VITLIEE 2025 Logical Reasoning Section (20 Questions)

This section checks your ability to think logically and solve puzzles or arguments.

### Assertion and Reason

You'll be given two statements (Assertion A and Reason R) and asked whether:

- Both are true
- One explains the other
- Either is false

**Analysis:** Evaluate arguments, identify assumptions, and distinguish between strong and weak reasoning.

**Relations:** Family-based reasoning (e.g., “A is the mother of B”), sequences, directions, coding-decoding, blood relations.

## VITLIEE Quantitative Aptitude Section (20 Questions)

This section tests your numerical and basic mathematical skills.

### Numerical Ability

Topics may include:

- Simplifications
- Number systems

- Percentages
- Profit & Loss
- Time and work
- Speed, distance, and time

### **Fundamental Mathematical Operations**
