## TS LAW CET Exam Pattern

Osmania University conducts the TS LAW CET exam in online mode. The exam is conducted at around 64 exam centres across Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. As per the exam pattern of TS LAW CET, there will be a total of 120 questions spread across the three sections as per their weight in the syllabus. The TS LAW CET exam pattern further states that out of the 120 questions, 10 questions will be based on comprehension of legal passages. The medium of the test will be English, Urdu and Telugu. Candidates can check the test pattern in the table given below.
