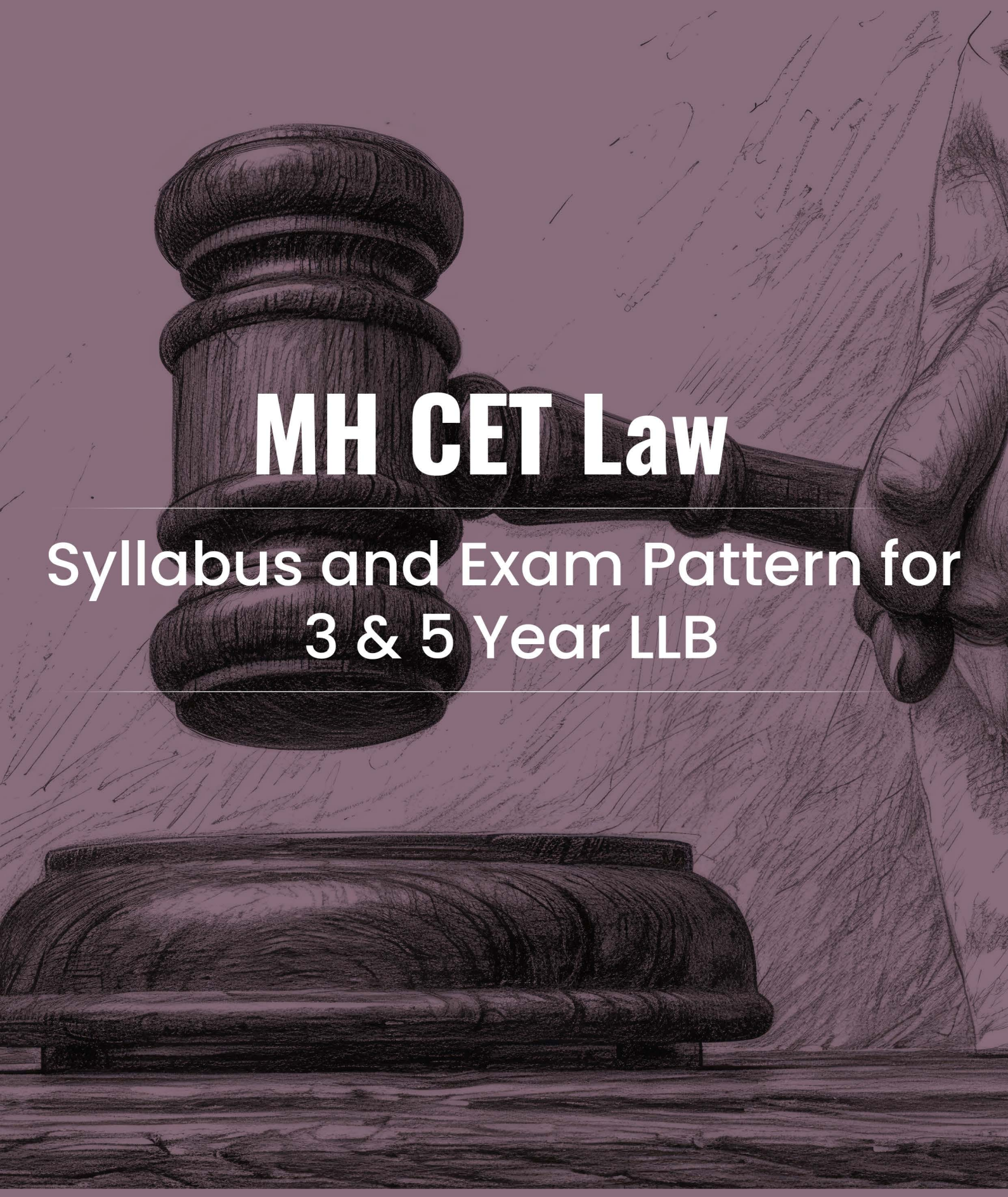

MH CET Law

Syllabus and Exam Pattern for
3 & 5 Year LLB



Introduction

The State Common Entrance Test Cell Maharashtra prescribes the MH CET law syllabus for the MH CET 3-year LLB and 5-year LLB entrance exam on its official website. From MH CET law 2025 onwards, the CET Cell has prescribed a revised [MH CET law exam pattern](#) for both 3-year LLB and 5-year LLB. It has reduced the number of questions to 120 from the earlier 150 questions. The total marks in LLB CET is reduced to 120. No changes have been made in the section-wise weights or duration of the MH CET law exam.

The [syllabus of MH CET law](#) includes the following sections: Legal aptitude and legal reasoning, General knowledge and current affairs, Logical and analytical reasoning, English and Maths. The LLB CET syllabus for the [3-year LLB](#) and [5-year LLB](#) programmes are similar with the exception of the Maths section. The MH CET 5-year LLB syllabus has a weightage of 10% for the maths section. [MH CET 3-year LLB](#) does not have a maths section. The remaining four sections are common to both the exams.



MH CET Law Syllabus - Overview

The table below provides an overview of the syllabus of MH CET Law, mentioning the sections and weightage given to each section. The total number of questions has been reduced by 20%. As a result the number of questions has been reduced by 20% in each of the sections.

MH CET Law Syllabus: Section-wise Details

Candidates who are appearing for the [Maharashtra State Common Entrance Test Law](#) must go through the LLB CET syllabus. There is not much difference between the MH CET 3-year LLB syllabus and the MH CET 5-year LLB syllabus. The MH CET Law syllabus tests a candidate's legal aptitude, reasoning skills, language proficiency and general awareness. The sections-wise MH CET Law syllabus is given below in detail.



Legal Aptitude And Legal Reasoning

Legal aptitude and legal reasoning are the most important sections in the MH CET law syllabus. This section of the MH CET law syllabus tests the suitability of the candidates to study law and the ability to reason with legal knowledge and students' problem solving abilities. Questions in the legal aptitude section test the candidate's ability to assess a set of legal propositions against certain facts and then draw logical conclusions. The topics in the Legal aptitude and legal reasoning section in the syllabus of MH CET Law are mentioned below:

Preparation Tips for Legal Aptitude And Legal Reasoning

- Collect study materials specific to the legal reasoning section. Candidates have to look for books that cover the legal concepts tested in the exam.
- Focus on understanding fundamental legal concepts and principles. Pay attention to topics such as Contracts, Torts, Constitutional law, and Legal Maxims.
- Analytical or critical skills play a major role in Legal Reasoning and thus can be developed by solving either logical puzzles or deciphering critical reasoning questions or scenarios.
- To be a good lawyer, candidates must build a strong legal vocabulary foundation. One needs to familiarise themselves with commonly used legal terms for example - legal maxims or idioms and phrases.
- Stay updated on current legal affairs and developments. This knowledge can be beneficial for questions related to recent legal events.

General Knowledge With Current Affairs

In both 3-year LLB and 5-year LLB tests, general knowledge and current affairs will test the knowledge of recent happenings as well as general awareness in the national and international arena from different fields. The MH CET Law syllabus for General knowledge includes the static GK and questions on current affairs. Candidates should know the current happening of the last one year. The topics in the General knowledge and current affairs section in the syllabus of MH CET Law are given below:

Preparation Tips for GK With Current Affairs

- Knowing the syllabus is an important topic for general knowledge and current affairs.
- Read newspapers such as the Hindu the Indian Express the Economic Times which will help the candidate to understand national and international, sports and economic news.
- Knowing the exam pattern is important to manage time and effort effectively during the exam.
- Properly solve the mocks within the time limit as its analysis is of utmost importance. However, 15 to 20 minutes are enough for this section.
- Set aside a dedicated timetable for studying other GK subjects, viewing news channels, and reading newspapers.
- Make quick notes while studying the static GK topics and note down important dates, statistics and information.
- Stay focused during the exam as it is important to kill the distractions during the exam as it is one of the top most priority in the exam

Logical And Analytical Reasoning

Logical reasoning and analytical reasoning will test the candidate's ability to identify the patterns, and logical links, draw conclusions, analogies and apply principles. It will also test the candidate's ability to identify and describe the relationship among persons, structures, and sets from given statements. The topics in the Logical reasoning and analytical reasoning section in the syllabus of MH CET Law are mentioned below:

Preparation Tips for Logical and Analytical Reasoning

- Engage in recognising and applying conditional statements, which are truths dependent on specific conditions.
- Train yourself to make decisions based on factual information rather than subjective feelings, ensuring a more logical approach.
- Develop awareness by paying attention to your surroundings. Concentrate on the different patterns, irregularities and details close to your surroundings.
- Do logical reasoning assessments which help to develop the ability for good decision-making.
- Attempt the mock test which simulates the real exam conditions and helps you analyse your weak and strong areas.

English

The English section of the MH CET Law syllabus tests the candidate's proficiency in the English language and their reading and comprehension abilities. This section will also focus on checking grammar, vocabulary, and reading skills. There will be a minimum of two passages in the English section to test the reading skills. Each passage will be followed by five to ten questions that test the reading as well as reasoning skills. The MH CET Law English syllabus covers vocabulary, English proficiency, English usage, and reading and comprehension.

Preparation Tips for English

- Candidates will have to develop a habit of constant reading. This would greatly improve reading speed and the candidate's ability to understand a subject. Better reading and comprehension skills will help a candidate read passages very quickly, and this is helpful in other sections as well.
- Improve vocabulary with the help of flashcards, and a dictionary and noting the meaning of difficult words that come up while reading.
- Develop attention to small details. This will help in summarising the passage and identifying the central idea contained in the passage.
- Practice mock English passages with a timer and answer the questions for better speed and time management.

Maths

The maths section in the MH CET LLB 5 years syllabus will test the numerical ability of the candidates. The questions in the LLB CET syllabus for maths is of class 10th level. The MH CET 3-year LLB syllabus does not have the maths section. The topics in the maths section in the syllabus of MH CET Law are given below:

Preparation Tips for Maths

- Indulge yourself in solving questions daily and improve your capabilities. As you practice many techniques to solve the questions, so you will become much more versatile.
- While practising Mathematics questions, carefully examine your answer. Especially, when you make mistakes that become one of the key steps for your process.
- Don't memorise the processes; just focus on how to understand the underlying logic.
- Whenever you are stuck at any point in the problem do not avoid it. Be patient with yourself while solving. Once you grasp the problem take it as a starting point and then work through the full question.
- Create a distraction-free study environment for math, that demands high concentration. Get rid of distractions and enhance your capacity to solve complicated problems in geometry, algebra, or trigonometry.
- Gather all notes, flashcards, or cheat sheets containing basic concepts, terminologies, and definitions of mathematics. Include meanings, key points, and sample answers for easy recall. It is a very helpful resource in reviewing and reinforcing your knowledge

MH CET Law Exam Pattern - Overview

The State Common Entrance Test Cell Maharashtra prescribes the MH CET law exam pattern. The MH CET law paper pattern has four sections that are common for 3-year LLB and 5-year LLB. The common sections of the MH CET law exam pattern are legal aptitude and legal reasoning, GK with current affairs, Logical and analytical reasoning, and English. Whereas, the MH CET 5-year LLB exam pattern has an additional Mathematics section.

The exam pattern of MH CET law tells about the general test modalities that are followed in the paper. It informs about the number of questions that will be asked in the test paper, time duration and other such vital information. Thus, for better preparation, candidates need to be aware of the test pattern. Candidates may refer to the table given below to know about the test pattern.
