# APNCET 2025 CUTOFF

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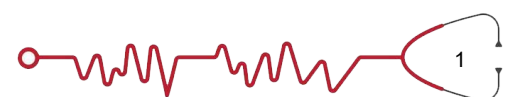


Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, AP, Vijayawada, conducts the Andhra Pradesh Nursing Common Entrance Test. The conducting authority releases the APNCET syllabus on the official website at [dntr.uhsap.in](http://dntr.uhsap.in). Before starting their preparation, candidates are advised to go through the Andhra Pradesh NCET syllabus once. APNCET exam is conducted every year in a computer-based mode.

According to the AP BSc nursing syllabus notification, the question paper is based on the syllabus of Class 12 of the State Board of Andhra Pradesh. The AP NCET exam will have 100 multiple-choice questions consisting of five subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English, and Nursing Aptitude. 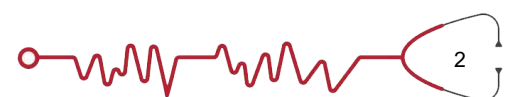
