CUET PG 2025: EXAM ANALYSIS

- The initial responses from candidates suggest that the CUET PG MBA 2025 examination was significantly more difficult than the previous year. Many test-takers found the overall difficulty level to be higher, especially in sections that required extensive calculations and reasoning. The unexpected increase in difficulty caught many candidates off guard, making it a challenging experience compared to the CUET PG MBA 2024 exam.
- An early analysis of the CUET PG MBA 2025 question paper indicates that the standard of questions was slightly more challenging. The difficulty increase was observed across multiple sections, with certain areas requiring deeper conceptual understanding. Candidates reported that the nature of the questions demanded greater problem-solving skills, making it tougher to complete the paper within the given time.
- One of the primary reasons for the increased difficulty level of the CUET PG MBA 2025 exam was the shortage of time. Many candidates struggled to attempt all the questions due to the lengthier calculations and complex reasoning problems. Time management became a crucial factor, and those who were unable to allocate their time efficiently found it difficult to complete the paper.
- In contrast to the CUET PG MBA 2024 examination, where the Logical Reasoning and Quantitative Aptitude sections were considered relatively easy and straightforward, this year, both sections were noticeably more challenging. The questions were lengthier, involving multiple steps, which made them time-consuming. The increased complexity in these sections led to additional pressure on candidates, making it harder to attempt all questions within the allotted time.
- The CUET PG MBA 2025 analysis also highlights a significant increase in the number of Data Interpretation (DI) sets. While the 2024 exam featured two sets of DI questions, each containing five questions, the 2025 exam had five sets of DI questions, with each set consisting of two questions. This change altered the question distribution, requiring candidates to shift their approach to solving DI problems effectively.
- Experts analyzing the CUET PG MBA 2025 question paper have concluded that it had a well-balanced mix of questions covering a wide range of topics. The diversity in question types ensured that all key areas were tested, making it essential for candidates to have a thorough understanding of the syllabus. The inclusion of questions from various difficulty levels ensured that only well-prepared candidates could perform exceptionally well.
- The English section of the CUET PG MBA 2025 question paper remained largely unchanged from the previous year. There were no major modifications in the pattern or difficulty level, providing some relief to candidates. Those who had prepared based on the previous year's format found this section manageable, as it retained a similar structure.
- The Quantitative Aptitude section was reported to be the most time-consuming among all sections in the CUET PG MBA 2025 examination. Candidates faced numerous lengthy calculations and multi-step problem-solving questions, which slowed down their

overall progress. The section's increased complexity required a strong grasp of mathematical concepts and quick calculation skills to efficiently tackle the problems.

- Due to the higher difficulty level of the CUET PG MBA 2025 exam, experts predict that the cutoffs for various universities are likely to be lower this year. With many candidates struggling to complete the paper and score high marks, the expected cutoffs are anticipated to drop in comparison to the previous year. This adjustment will provide some relief to test-takers who found the exam particularly challenging.
- Further analysis of the CUET PG MBA 2025 exam reveals the topic-wise distribution of questions in the Quantitative Aptitude section. Candidates encountered 1-2 questions from the quantitative aptitude topic, 2-3 questions from profit and loss, and another 1-2 questions from Simple Interest and Compound Interest. These topics remained consistent with previous years, though the complexity of the questions was higher.
- In addition, the CUET PG MBA 2025 question paper featured 2 questions from Time and Distance, 1-2 questions from Pipes and Cisterns, and one question on Partnership. These topics are commonly tested in management entrance exams, and their presence in this year's exam indicates a continued emphasis on fundamental quantitative concepts.
- The Logical Reasoning section in the CUET PG MBA 2025 question paper covered a variety of topics, including Alphabet Reasoning, Coding and Decoding, Venn Diagrams, Statement and Arguments, and Syllogism. The inclusion of multiple questions from Coding and Decoding highlights the importance of this topic in logical reasoning. Candidates who had practiced these types of questions extensively were better positioned to tackle this section effectively.

1. A car and bus were moving on a road. They were 60 KM apart. After 3 hours, it was found that the car overtook the bus and they are now 90 away from the bus. The speed of the bus was 45 km/hr. Find the speed of the car.

2. A invested P amount in Compound Interest for 2 years at 12% and B invested P+300 for 3 years. The final amount calculated for both A and B was the same. Find the actual amount.

(Ans: Rs 50,000)

3. To fill a tank, a pipe was opened at 6 PM, another pipe B at 7 AM and a third pipe C at 8 AM. The pipe A takes 10 hours to fill a tank, while B needs 15 hours to fill. C can do the same in 20 hours. The pipe C requires rest after 3 hours. How much time will it take to completely fill the tank?

(Ans: 5 5/6 hours).
