The GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test) is a standardized exam that measures verbal, quantitative, analytical writing, and integrated reasoning skills to assess academic readiness for graduate-level study in business and management programs.

GMAT Syllabus: Overview

The GMAT examination syllabus for 2025 consists of three main sections:

1. Quantitative Reasoning
2. Verbal Reasoning
3. Data Insights

The total duration of the GMAT exam is 2 hours and 15 minutes, with an optional 10-minute break. The exam comprises 64 questions in total, with specific time allocations for each section.

The Quantitative Reasoning section of the GMAT exam syllabus consists of 21 multiple-choice questions to be answered within 45 minutes. This section evaluates the candidate's understanding and application of algebra and arithmetic fundamentals in problem-solving scenarios.

GMAT Exam Syllabus Verbal Reasoning

The Verbal Reasoning section of the GMAT exam syllabus consists of 23 multiple-choice questions to be answered within 45 minutes. This GMAT section measures the candidate's ability to read and comprehend given data, reason and evaluate arguments, and correct sentences to form standard written English.

GMAT Data Insights Syllabus

The newly introduced Data Insights section of the GMAT syllabus comprises 20 questions to be answered within 45 minutes. This section evaluates the candidate's data literacy skills, including data sufficiency, table analysis, multi-source reasoning, graphics interpretation, and two-part analyses.

GMAT Syllabus 2025 Changes

The GMAT exam syllabus for 2025 has introduced the following changes compared to the previous version:

- Removal of the Analytical Writing Assessment and Integrated Reasoning sections
- Addition of the Data Insights section
- Reduction in the total number of questions from 80 to 64
- Decrease in the total exam duration from 3 hours and 7 minutes to 2 hours and 15 minutes (with an optional 10-minute break)
