NEET CUTOFF FOR MBBS

NEET cut off for government colleges: Qualifying marks vs admission cut off

The NEET UG cutoff for MBBS is of two types - qualifying cut-off marks and admission cutoff. The NEET qualifying cutoff marks are the minimum marks a candidate needs to score to qualify NEET exam. Candidates who score the qualifying cutoff marks are eligible to participate in the [NEET counselling](#) process. The NTA releases the NEET qualifying cutoff along with the results.

The NEET cut off for admission is the last rank at which admission is granted to the applicants in the government medical colleges. The NEET qualified candidates need to score at least the minimum marks in order to get admission to a particular medical college. The admission cutoff of NEET is released by the participating institute after each counselling round.

NEET cut off for government colleges

The [NEET cut off](#) for government colleges is the minimum rank which is required to get admission in the particular college after the counselling process. The All India Quota NEET cut off for top government medical colleges in India can be checked from the table below.
