INTRODUCTION

Dr NTR University of Health Sciences (NTRUHS), Vijayawada, is the competent authority which will administer Medical and Dental admission in Andhra Pradesh. Candidates will be required to fill the application form to get admission in 85% of MBBS and BDS state quota seats offered under Category of A, B and C. Candidates who will submit the application form will be included in the AP merit list.

Only those candidates whose name appears on the final merit list will be invited to participate in counselling. The authority will organise the counselling process for admission under capable authority and management quota seats as well. Admission will commence with the release of candidates who have qualified the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET). The Ebook of "Andhra Pradesh NEET MBBS BDS Admission" contains all the basic and important details of the medical admission in the state like the important dates, application procedure, merit list, counselling procedure and cutoffs required for admission.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility reflects the basic prerequisite conditions that candidates must meet to get admission in MBBS and BDS courses. The state specific eligibility criteria has been given below.

Candidate must be the domicile of the state by fulfilling one of the below mentioned criteria

- ❖ Local candidate as defined in the Presidential order.
- ❖ Candidate or one of the candidate's parents' lived in the state at least ten years excluding the period where the aspirant has studied outside the state or the parents have resided outside Andhra Pradesh.
- ❖ Candidates whose parents are in the employment of the Central or State Government, Public Sector Corporation Universities, Local Bodies and other similar Public Institution within the state to be eligible for admission.
- ❖ The candidate whose spouse is in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority of the state.

APPLICATION FORM

Medical aspirants will be required to fill the application form in online mode. To successfully submit the application form, candidates will have to fill in details like NEET marks, rank, permanent address, local and non-local status to submit the application form. At last, aspirants have to submit the application form prescribed fee of Rs.2950/- for unreserved category and BC category. The reserved category candidates will have to pay Rs.2360/-The steps to fill the application form can be checked from below.

Steps to fill the application form

- NEET admit card
- NEET score card
- Class 10 pass certificate/Date of birth certificate
- Class 12 or equivalent examination mark sheet
- Transfer Certificate issued from the last attended institute
- Pass certificate from Class 6 to Class 12
- Permanent caste certificate, if necessary
- Aadhaar Card
- Minority certificate, if applicable
- Candidates who have studied outside Andhra Pradesh are required to show the resident certificate stating that s/he is residing in the state for 10 years.
- Income certificate, if claiming fee exemption
- Undertaking signed by the parents and candidates that document pertaining to caste and area are original.
- Local status certificate
- Special category, if available

MERIT LIST

Candidates who will successfully submit the application form will be included in the provisional merit list. The merit list will be released separately for management quota and convener quota seats. The authority will also release a list of candidates who have qualified NEET 2025 from the state. The list contains the candidate's name, NEET roll no., NEET rank, score, and state merit rank. The mode of release of the merit list is only online. The merit list will be determined by NEET UG scores after verification of uploaded certificates by the University and officials of concerned departments as per eligibility rules/ regulations.

The inclusion in the final merit list for counselling will indicate candidates are allowed to participate in the counselling process.

COUNSELLING

Dr. NTRUHS, Vijaywada will start the counselling in online mode. Only aspirants whose names will be included in the state merit list will be called for counselling for admission to MBBS and BDS seats offered in Medical and Dental colleges of the state. In order to appear for counselling, it is mandatory for candidates to appear and qualify NEET exam by securing the minimum qualifying percentile.

The counselling will be conducted in three rounds which includes first, second and Third round for competent and management quota students separately. Before the commencement of counselling, aspirants need to provide their preferences of colleges as well as courses. Considering these choices filled, seats available, NEET result, reservation criteria and other factors, the admission will be granted. After the seat is allotted, eligible candidates need to report at the respective colleges for document verification and completion of the admission process.
