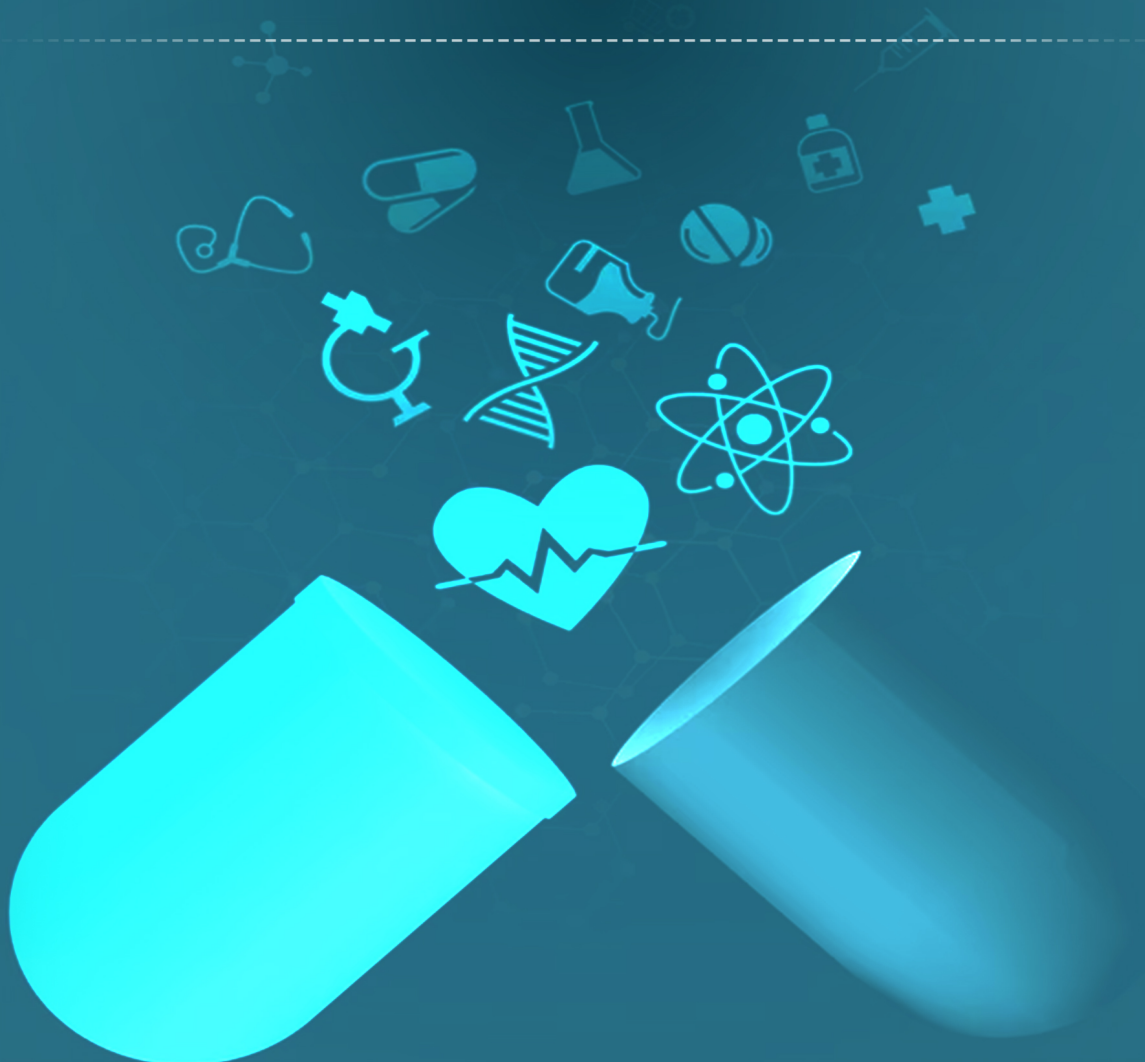

Introduction

The Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Assam is the authority responsible for UG Medical and Dental admissions. Candidates who will qualify NEET and meet the eligibility guidelines can register and fill the application form and register for state counselling. During the counselling procedure, they have to provide their preferences for colleges. According to the provided preferences, NEET rank, seats available, reservation criteria and other details, the seats will be allotted.

The authority will conduct the seat allotment process for admission to MBBS and BDS seats offered by the government and private colleges located in the state. The admission to medical & dental courses done by DME, Assam on the basis of NEET scores under 85% state quota seats. The remaining 15% seats from all government medical and dental colleges will be reserved for All India Quota shortlisted candidates, which will be conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)

This Ebook for Assam NEET 2023 MBBS BDS admission will help candidates to understand the process of admission in MBBS and BDS courses in the colleges of Assam, including important dates, application form, eligibility criteria, merit list, counselling, reservation criteria, closing ranks and participating institutes.

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must go through the eligibility criteria before applying for the state medical or dental admission. Below are the eligibility guidelines set by the Directorate of Medical Education.

Nationality

A candidate should be an Indian citizen or Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs) cardholder should satisfy the local or non-local status of Assam.

Age

Candidates applying for Assam medical admission should be 17 years old at the end of December 31

Educational Qualification

- ❖ Candidates should have passed the Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English as the core subjects.
- ❖ Open Category (OC) must obtain not less than 60%.
- ❖ Aspirants belonging to BC/SC/ST and OC-PWD category need to secure 50% marks.

Domicile Criteria

- ❖ Students must have studied from class VII to XII from the schools of Assam state.
- ❖ Every candidate should be medically fit.
- ❖ The candidate or candidate's parents must be a permanent resident of Assam state for at least 20 years.

Entrance Examination

It is mandatory to appear and qualify in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test - NEET-UG entrance exam. Candidates securing the minimum qualifying percentile will be considered qualified. The cutoff percentile varies for all categories, which is mentioned in the table below

Application Form

The application form will be available on the official website of DME in online mode. Candidates who have qualified NEET are eligible to fill the application form on or before the last date. It is to be noted that in order to submit the application form successfully, candidates have to submit the below mentioned details carefully.

Personal details:

- Name of the candidate
- Father's name
- Mother's name
- Postal address
- Mobile number
- Email ID
- Date of Birth
- Category of the candidate

Academic details:

- Details of the examination passed
- Percentage of marks obtained in Higher Secondary/10+2 or equivalent examination

Documents required for application form

Candidates are needed to submit the documents at the time of counselling. All the documents that are mandatory are listed below. These documents must be submitted along with the self-attested photocopy.

- NEET Result
- Class 12 passing certificate
- Class 12 mark sheet
- Class 10 passing certificate
- Class 12 mark sheet
- NEET UG admit card
- Assam NEET application form
- Date of Birth certificate
- Identification proofs (Driving License/PAN Card/ Voter ID Card/ Passport)
- Caste certificate provided by a competent authority
- Certificate of Permanent residence
- Fresh passport size photographs
- Certificate of physical disability, if applicable

Merit List

The DME will release the state medical and dental merit list in online mode based on the marks obtained by the candidates in NEET. Aspirants who are a resident of Assam and will secure the minimum qualifying percentile will be added in the state merit list. The list will include the names, NEET scores and percentile, AIR and state merit rank of the candidates qualified in the medical entrance exam and have a permanent domicile of the state.

Based on the merit rank, eligible candidates will be called for the counselling session for admission to MBBS and BDS seats under 85% state quota seats. On the other hand, 15% will be reserved for students selected under All India Quota seats.

Counseling

The Directorate of Medical Education, Assam will release the list of the candidates eligible for the counselling process. The admission is for the 85% state quota seats offered in medical and dental colleges in the state. The counselling for the rest 15% All India Quota seats will be conducted by Medical Counselling Committee i.e. MCC. The counselling will be held in offline mode in two rounds. Candidates who have qualified the NEET entrance exam will be called for counselling.

During the counselling process, aspirants will be provided the number of colleges as per their preferences. Candidates need to provide their preferences of colleges in which they wish to get admission as per their NEET rank. On the basis of preferences provided, seats available, NEET merit rank, reservation criteria and other factors, the admission to Assam MBBS/BDS will be granted.

The counselling process is online. Candidates must register and then fill their choices. Allotment will be announced based on the merit of the applicants. Once allotment is announced, candidates must download the allotment letter and report to the college for document verification and completion of admission formalities.

Note: Special quota candidates will have to report for document verification separately as notified by the authorities.

Counselling rounds-

Round 1: Candidates must report within the specified dates along with original documents, admission and counselling fees of Rs 25000. They are required to deposit the original documents with the principal of the allotted college. Admission is subject to satisfactory Medical fitness certificate of the candidates.

Round 2: The process is the same as round 1 for candidates who have not been allotted any seat in round 1. However, candidates who have opted to upgrade in round 2 will have to first collect their original documents with release letter from the respective principals of the colleges allotted in round 1. They can only report to the college allotted in round 2 after receipt of the documents and release letter. In such a case the seat allotted in round 1 will stand cancelled.

The process is the same for round 3, stray round and special stray round.

Seats Reservation

As per the reservation criteria, SC, ST, OBC and PwD candidates are given
