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ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION-

Age limit: Candidates must be at least 17 years of age.

Nativity:

Keralite: A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorised as a 'Keralite'.

Non-Keralite Category I- Candidate who is not of Kerala origin but fulfils anyone of the following conditions will be categorised as 'Non-Keralite Category I'

- a) A candidate who has undergone qualifying course in Kerala and who is son/daughter of Non-Keralite parents belonging to Government of India/Defence Service, posted to Kerala.
- b) A candidate who has undergone qualifying course in Kerala and who is son/daughter of Non-Keralite parents who are serving/served Government of Kerala for a minimum period of two years.
- c) A candidate who is not of Kerala Origin but has been a resident of Kerala State for a period of 5(five) years within the period of 12(twelve) years of his/her study.
- d) A candidate who is not of Kerala Origin but who has undergone his/her school studies in Kerala from standard VIII to XII.

Non-Keralite Category II - Candidates who do not come under 'Keralite' or 'Non-Keralite Category I' will be categorised as 'Non-Keralite Category II'.

Academic Eligibility: Candidates who have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually at the Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or examinations recognised equivalent thereto and obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology are eligible For admission to MBBS, BDS Courses.

Seat Reservations

- 1) 15% of the total sanctioned seats in MBBS/BDS Courses in Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges in the State.
- 2) 15% Reservation for All India Quota for MBBS Courses in Self-Financing Medical Colleges.
- 3) Reservation for Nominees.
- 4) Reservation for Persons with Disabilities
- 5) Mandatory Reservation-all types of supernumerary seats sanctioned and Management Quota, the remaining Government seats for each course in Govt./Aided/KAU/KVASU/KUFOS Colleges.

Types of Seats-

Government seats: Merit seats against which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment are called 'Government Seats'.

Management Seats: The seats set apart in the Aided institutions, to be filled up by the Managements concerned are called Management Seats.

APPLICATION FORM

Candidates seeking admission to Kerala NEET courses have to fill the application form in the online mode. It is to be noted that in order to submit the application form successfully, candidates have to submit the application fee through credit/debit cards, net banking, and E-challan.

The application process for admission is a five-step process. Candidate has to visit the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in for the entire process.

(ii) If the date of birth is not mentioned in the SSLC Certificates candidate should upload an equivalent certificate to prove date of birth (Mandatory).

(c) 12th Marksheet

d)Non-Creamy Layer Certificate,Community Certificate,Certificates for special reservation,Documents of Minority reservation,EWS Certificate whichever is needed for the particular category filled.

e)Documents for NRI Quota reservation-

- ❖ Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy or Consulate authorities / GreenCard/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) documents of their respective sponsors mentioning the job of the sponsor.
- ❖ In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents,the candidate has to produce the Employment Certificate of the Sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.
- ❖ The Certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the Revenue authorities

MERIT LIST

CEE Kerala is the body responsible for releasing the merit list. Based on the scores obtained in the NEET exam, the merit list will be prepared. Merit list displays the name of candidates, merit rank, roll number, All India Rank and other details. Candidates included in the merit list will be allowed for admission under 85% state quota seats.

Once the merit list is published, the eligible students will be called for the counselling process. Aspirants whose name will be listed on the merit list must fill their choices of colleges and courses through online mode. Based on the state merit rank, choices filled, seat availability in a particular college and reservation criteria, admission will be granted.

A common and category-wise merit list will be released. The merit list will include the name of candidates, merit position, NEET roll number, All India Rank and other details. In case two or more candidates get the same rank, the authority will follow the required tie-breaking process.

COUNSELLING

The counselling will be conducted through online Centralised Admission Process(CAP) .It consists of four rounds of counselling namely Round I, Round II, Mop-up round & Stray vacancy round.Based on the choices filled by the candidates, seats will be allotted in various MBBS and BDS colleges. Since the mode of conduct of counselling is online, candidates will be required to submit web options for submitting preferences.

The counselling result will be released in the online mode in the form of seat allotment list. The list will contain the name of the candidates, the course and college allotted, the category of seat and candidate's category. Candidates whose names are included in the seat allotment must report to the allotted college between the given time to take admission.

Counselling Rules -

Round1-

- 1) Fresh Registration
- 2) Candidates allotted to a course through Round I should physically report at the allotted college within the date notified by the CEE by paying the fees.
- 3)Those candidates who did not join the allotted college and taken exit within the given time will not be considered for Round II, but can register options afresh in Mop-up round.

Round 2-

- 1) No fresh Registration.
- 2)Fresh choice filling is to be done.
- 3)If a candidate is satisfied with allotment received through Round I and does not want to participate further they need to cancel all the remaining options followed by Option Confirmation.
Option confirmation is mandatory for considering options in Round II.
- 4)Those candidates who did not join the allotted college and took exit within the given time can register options fresh in the Mop-up round.

Mop-up Round-

- 1) Fresh registration can be done by them who have not registered in any Round or who have taken exit from allotted seats in earlier Rounds
- Stray vacancy round-1)No fresh registration
- 2)It is conducted only if seats are vacant after mop-up round
- 3)The Stray vacancy filling will be conducted at the institutional level where vacancy exists.
