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INTRODUCTION

Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences (KNRUHS) is the competent authority to conduct Telangana Medical admission for the state and management quota Medical and Dental seats. Candidates who fulfill certain eligibility criteria set by the state will be allowed to fill the application form for admission. While filling out the application form, aspirants need to register themselves by entering their roll number, rank, and mobile number. It is also mandatory for applicants to qualify NEET UG Exam. The remaining 15% seats from all government medical colleges will be reserved for All India Quota students, which will be filled by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) based on NEET UG scores.

Using the NEET details mentioned in the application form, the authority will prepare the merit list. According to the state merit rank, candidates will be called for counselling procedure. During the counselling, aspirants will be required to enter their preferences of colleges and courses. Based on the choices, state merit rank, and seats available in each course, the seat allotment process will be done. Aspirants can check the Ebook on "NEET: Telangana State Counselling" to know the details about it.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

This includes a set of conditions required to be fulfilled by candidates in order to secure a seat in medical admission in the state. For the convenience of candidates these have been listed below:

- ❖ A candidate should be an Indian citizen or Person of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs) cardholder and should satisfy the local or non-local status in Telangana.
- ❖ One must be a local or non-local candidate of Telangana

A. **Local Candidate** - Such aspirants will be eligible for 85% state quota seats and 15% All India Quota seats as well. He/she must fulfill the following conditions.

1. If the candidate has studied in an Educational Institutions in such a local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he had resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana.

B. **Non Local Candidate** - Non local candidates are eligible for 15% Unreserved seats only (in colleges established before 02-06-2014). Local candidates are also eligible for 15% Unreserved seats along with 85% seats reserved for Local areas.

- Candidates should have passed their Class 12 examination or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English to be eligible
- It is important for the unreserved category to secure 50% in Class 12 or equivalent exam, while reserved category students must have obtained 40% taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology or English.
- Aspirants must obtain the minimum NEET qualifying marks.

Age: Candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December.

APPLICATION FORM

The conducting authorities will start the online registration for medical admission in online mode at the official website. Prior to that authorities will release an eligible applicant list consisting of names of candidates who will qualify NEET with the minimum qualifying percentile. Such candidates will be eligible to fill the medical application form. Candidates will have to register themselves for MBBS admission by following the steps given below:

How to fill the Application Form?

In order to register themselves for admission, candidates can read the stepwise procedure below.

Step 1 - Online registration

Aspirants have to visit the KNRUHS official website. Use the link stating "Online Registration" displayed on the screen. Thereafter, candidates need to enter their NEET rank, roll number (as mentioned in NEET UG admit card), and valid mobile number to validate themselves.

Step 2 - Payment of application fees

For MQ

Registration and Processing fee Rs. 6300/- (Rupees Six Thousand Three hundreds only) Bank transaction charges extra.

FOR CQ

The Registration and Processing fee Rs.3,500/- (Bank transaction charges extra) for OC & BC candidates and Rs.2,900/- (Bank transaction charges extra) for SC/ST candidates shall be paid online through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.

1. Open the website <https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/> Home page displayed as follows.

- There are 4 steps to register for UG admission program i.e
- a. Mobile and Email Registration,
 - b. Candidate Registration (Payment of fee),
 - c. Updating of data

Step 3 - Login

The registration number allotted after registration must be used along with the NEET roll number to log in for filling the application form. The registration number must be noted and preserved for future use.

Step 4 - Filling of academic and personal details

After logging in, the application form will appear on the screen, where the following personal, academic, category, communication, and other details must be entered.

Step 5 - Uploading of Documents

Aspirants have to upload the required scanned copies of original documents.

Step 6 - Declaration form

Every candidate whose application form is filled must click on the box provided for the declaration form which states that the information provided by them is correct and any false information will lead to the cancellation of the candidature.

Step 7 - Printout of Confirmation Page

Once the application form is successfully submitted, the confirmation page will be displayed on the screen. Aspirants are advised to take a printout of the confirmation page for future references.

MERIT LIST

Only the registered aspirants will be included in the provisional merit list. The authority will publish the provisional merit list for Convener Quota and for management quota. After scrutiny of the uploaded document, the authority will publish the final merit list on the official website. Candidates whose names appear on the final merit list will be eligible to participate in the further counselling process.

It is mandatory for aspirants to qualify NEET entrance exam by securing the minimum qualifying percentile. The final merit list will display the names of the candidate, NEET roll number, state merit rank, category, the local or non-local status of aspirants. Inclusion in the state merit list will permit them to appear for online counselling.

COUNSELLING

KNRUHS will conduct **four rounds** of counselling for admission to the Medical and Dental seats offered in the state. It is essential for medical aspirants to secure a position in the merit list in order to be eligible for counselling. Candidates will have to register themselves for the same by entering details like their choice of college and course in which they wish to get admission through Telangana MBBS counselling. Candidates who will be allotted seats must report at the respective colleges for document verification and completion of the admission process.

The authority will conduct the second round of counselling to fill the remaining vacant seats left. The counselling is being conducted for 85% state quota seats. The remaining 15% seats from all government MBBS and BDS colleges are reserved for All India Quota seats. The counselling for AIQ seats is held by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) based on the scores obtained in NEET. In order to appear for counselling, the eligible candidates must register themselves through the same portal used for application form

Important Rules:

MBBS/BDS ADMISSIONS UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA

1. If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS/BDS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, he/she shall not be permitted to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling and admission to prevent seat blocking.
2. Candidates notified in the Provisional final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.
3. Candidates exercising web-options for MBBS/BDS courses are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options.
4. Free exit till 2nd round of admitted candidates but they will not be eligible for further round of counseling for Competent Authority Quota for MBBS course once they discontinue the course.

MBBS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA

1. The Candidates who were allotted seats in the first phase of counseling and have not reported/discontinued the course after joining at the respective college are not eligible for exercising options.
2. Candidates who have not exercised web options in the first phase of counseling are not eligible to exercise web options.

3. The candidates who were allotted MBBS seats in the first phase of counseling and joined the course and continuing in the course are eligible to exercise web options and are informed to exercise web options.

Round 2:

- If a seat is allotted in this phase of counseling as per web options exercised by the candidate in this phase of counseling, the seat allotted in 1st phase of counseling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate.
- Candidates are informed that if they exercise web- options for a seat and are allotted a MBBS seat as per their choice in the web- counseling and if they do not join the course at the allotted college, they will not be eligible for exercising web- options for subsequent rounds of counseling.

Mop up Round:

- 1) The Candidates who were allotted seats in the previous phases of counseling and have not reported/discontinued the course after joining at the respective college are not eligible for exercising options.
- 2) Candidates who have not exercised web options in the first phase of counseling are not eligible to exercise web options.
- 3) The candidates who were allotted MBBS seats in the previous phases of counseling and joined the course and continuing in the course are eligible to exercise web options and are informed to exercise web options.
- 4) Admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw/discontinue from the course after Mop up phase of counseling.
- 5) If a seat is allotted in this phase of counseling as per web options exercised by the candidate in this phase of counseling, the seat allotted in previous phases of counseling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.

PENAL ACTION (For Management Quota) :

Candidates will not be permitted to withdraw from the course after the Mop-up phase of counseling (last date of free exit shall be notified by KNRUHS on website). If Candidates want to discontinue the course after Mop-up phase of counseling they have to pay discontinuation fee of **Rs. 20,00,000/-** (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only) to the University and will also be debarred for three years from admissions into the same course under KNRUHS.

Discontinuation fee: (For Competent Authority Quota)

Candidates cannot discontinue from the course after notified cutoff date for dis-continuation or later. Candidates will have to submit a bond for the same. Candidates shall pay a Bond amount of **Rs. 20, 00,000/-** (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only) if they discontinue the course after the last date of free exit.
