Introduction

The Odisha Joint Entrance Examination (OJEE) cell is responsible for conducting the Odisha MBBS counselling. Odisha is a closed state and if outside state candidates want to apply they will have to apply for NRI seats.

Eligibility

- ❖ The candidates must be of 17 years of age as on December 31 and there will be no upper age limit.
- ❖ Candidates must have qualified NEET-UG.
- ❖ The candidates must be permanent natives of Odisha or Children of All India Civil Service officers who are serving in state of Odisha cadre
- ❖ Candidates must have passed class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology, and English from a recognised board and scored at least 50% marks for unreserved and General EWS candidates for Scheduled Tribes, or Other Backward Classes (NCL) and PwBD SC/ST candidates its 40% and 45% for benchmark disability candidates (PC-GE)

Eligibility for NRI-

- ❖ The NRI candidates who have qualified NEET exam are eligible.
- ❖ NRI means the children of a person of Indian origin residing outside India. Such candidates have to submit the following documents in support of NRI:
 1. Documents claiming that the sponsorer is an NRI like passport, visa of the sponsor
 2. Relation of NRI with the candidate
 3. Affidavit from the sponsor that he/ She will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate duly notarized
 4. Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer.

Reservation

Scheduled Tribe (ST) - 12%

Scheduled Caste (SC) - 8%

Physically Challenged (PC) - 5% of each category

Ex-Servicemen (ES) - 3%

Green Card Holders (GC) - 5%

State Government Schools (SG) – 15%

EWS – 10%

Note-

- ❖ There is no OBC category, such candidates are considered in General Category
- ❖ Candidates claiming seats under SG (State Government Schools) reservation category must have passed their 10th Board Examination under the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha from Government High Schools and also have passed the 12th Board Examination under the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha from any Government Higher Secondary School/Government Junior College.
- ❖ The ST/SC candidates must produce caste certificates from Odisha State only to get the privilege of reservation in the category in Odisha.
- ❖ If sufficient numbers of candidates are not available in any Reserve category, the vacant seats will be filled up by UR category.
- ❖ The ST/SC seats are not interchangeable.

- ❖ Class 10th Certificate (for Date of Birth verification)
- ❖ Class 12th Marksheet
- ❖ Class 12th Certificate
- ❖ NEET-2024 Rank Card
- ❖ Photograph
- ❖ Nativity Certificate (proof of being Native of Odisha) /Residence Certificate will not be considered
- ❖ Certificate to Claim Reservation, if any (SC/ST/GC/EWS)
- ❖ Bond, prepared and signed in proper manner

Fee Structure

1. For Government Medical/Dental Colleges - Rs. 37,950/- per annum.
2. Fees for MBBS course in Private Medical Colleges:
 - *Hi-Tech MCH Bhubaneswar - Rs.6,50,000/- per annum
 - *Hi-Tech MCH Rourkela - Rs.5,50,000/- per annum
 - *DRIEMS Institute of Health Sciences & Hospital - Rs.6,50,000/- per annum
3. Fees to be deposited for Private (Hi-Tech) Dental Colleges is Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum.
4. NRI candidates have to pay four times the above fees in private colleges.

Steps of Counselling Process

Step 1-Payment of counselling fees online

Step 2-Preliminary Registration

Step 3-Online Application

Step 4-Final submission and print out of online Application

Step 5-Document Verification

Step 6-Publication of Merit List & Reject List

Step 7-Grievance to Merit List

Step 8-Publication of Seat Matrix

Step 9-Online Choice filling & Locking (Different Round)

Step 10-Allotment /Download Allotment Letter

Step 11-Provisional Admission

Step 12-Spot Round / Mopup Round / Stray Vacancy Round

Step 13-Publication of final Admission List

Step 14-Commencement of course

Procedure of Online Counselling

- ❖ Registration has to be done by the eligible candidates.
- ❖ Choice filling and locking has to be done by the candidates.
- ❖ Allotment is done and candidates can download the allotment letter. If a candidate gets the seat as per their 1st choice and takes admission for that seat, then they cannot participate in subsequent rounds of counseling. If allotment is not as per 1st choice, then they can decide whether or not to participate in subsequent rounds for improvement only. (Candidates can opt for Freeze or Float)
- ❖ In 2nd round, all the newly registered candidates who successfully get their documents verified, unallotted candidates of 1st round and candidates who were allotted seats in first round but not reported for admission, have to fill and lock fresh sets of choices within due date and time.
- ❖ Candidates who opted for the **Freeze and Float** option **will not be** doing fresh choice filling.
- ❖ Candidates opted for 'float' option and if upgraded then the candidate shall have to accept the upgraded seat and shall not have claim over the previous round allotted seat.
- ❖ In Round 3, If a candidate is allotted a seat for the 1st time, the candidate cannot upgrade or resign. If any candidate does not join Round 3 seat, they may exit with withdraw elimination and they cannot participate in any further rounds
- ❖ If at the end of 3 rd round of counseling,if vacancy still exists due to any reason, upgradation /sliding among existing candidates, who have given willingness as to be in float option, will be done
- ❖ If some vacancy is left out, then spot counseling (mop up) can be held where physical presence of the candidate is a must for participating in the spot counseling.The candidates who have taken admission at the end of 3 rd round counseling (All India / State) are not eligible to participate in spot counseling.
- ❖ In case the candidate resigns after admission on or before the designated date for withdrawal / resignation, he/she shall get back 90% of admission fees deposited and 10% of the admission fees will be deducted as processing fees. No candidates will be allowed to resign after the date is over. Any candidate resigns after due date seat no fees will be refunded and the candidate shall be liable for a financial penalty.
