Introduction

Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFUHS) conducts admission for filling UG medical and dental seats in participating colleges of Punjab. Admission is conducted for admission to 85% state quota seats in government and government-aided and all seats in private colleges. Admission will be based on NEET UG scores of the current session.

The merit list will be released category-wise, based on the marks obtained in NEET. Please note only those candidates whose names appear in the lists will be eligible for counselling, which will be conducted in online mode .

Eligibility Criteria

NEET cutoff percentile

As per the eligibility criteria for admission, candidates must secure cutoff percentile as set by the National Testing Agency (NTA), to be included in the merit list.

Applicants seeking admission to UG medical and dental courses have to meet the prescribed eligibility criteria. The key eligibility criteria is that one has to meet the age limit, domicile, and academic requirements as explained below:

1. Nationality : Only Indian nationals can apply.
2. Domicile : Also, the candidate must be a bonafide resident of Punjab.

However, the following candidates can also apply:

- ❖ Candidates who are sons and daughters of late employees of Punjab Government/ Central Government/All India Services.
- ❖ Children of late employees of military/ex-military/ paramilitary forces, born in the territory of Punjab.
- ❖ Children of defense personnel posted in Punjab.
- ❖ Minority and NRI candidates may also apply

Note: Apart from above permanent residents means:-

- Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years preceding the qualifying examination for the admission, or
- However, in case an adequate number of candidates is not available for BDS course, then candidates who are not eligible for state quota may be considered.

3. Age limit: He/she has completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete that age on or before 31 December of the year of his/her admission.

4. Qualifying exam: The candidate must have passed 10+2 exams with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English, having passed each of these subjects individually. The candidate also needs to score 50% aggregate marks in PCB (or PCB/Biotechnology) combination. PwD candidates need 45% marks, while reserved category candidates need only 40% marks

APPLICATION FORM

The application form filling process includes steps like registration, uploading of documents and payment of application fee.

How to fill application form

Registration - The applicant has to first get registered by entering mobile number and email id, name, NEET roll number and AIR, among other details. Upon successful registration, registration number and password will be generated.

Following documents are required to be uploaded for the online registration:

- i. Soft copy of Photograph of the candidate (Maximum size 30 KB).
- ii. Soft copy of the signatures of the candidate (Maximum Size 30 KB)

Candidates shall submit online ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM only once. Applications submitted more than once are liable to be rejected.

After the last date for applying online, it will get locked automatically. Thereafter no change (regarding any particulars) can be made and no request/application will be considered/accepted, in this regard.

Payment of application fee - The fee can be paid online through net banking. Also, challan payment is also available, for which the candidate has to first download and take a printout of the Bank e-challan which will be generated after registration.

- Uploading of documents - Photograph, signature, left thumb impression and other documents have to be uploaded in prescribed format.
- Taking printout of application form - The candidate will be able to take a printout of the application form once it is locked, after the cutoff date.

Document Verification

The document verification process will be conducted in offline mode. Candidates who have successfully filled the application form have to report at the assigned document verification centers and get their documents verified.

MERIT LIST

BFUHS will release merit lists separately for different categories including NRI categories. The merit lists will be prepared based on NEET scores; so only those candidates who qualify in the national-level exam will be included in the lists. Also, candidates whose names appear in any of the published merit lists will be eligible to participate in the counselling process.

The merit list will include details like the name of the candidate, registration number, category code, NEET 2024 roll number, marks and rank, and percentile.

Tie-breaker

Tie-Breaking criteria is used when two or more candidates score the same marks in NEET. There are four parameters which will be used for the candidates who have scored the same marks -

- ❖ Candidates with more marks in Biology will be preferred over the one with lesser marks.
- ❖ If the tie does not break, then marks in Chemistry will be considered and the candidate who has scored higher marks will be given preference.
- ❖ Next, the candidate with lesser wrong answers will be preferred.
- ❖ If the tie still persists, then the candidate who is older in age will be considered.

COUNSELLING

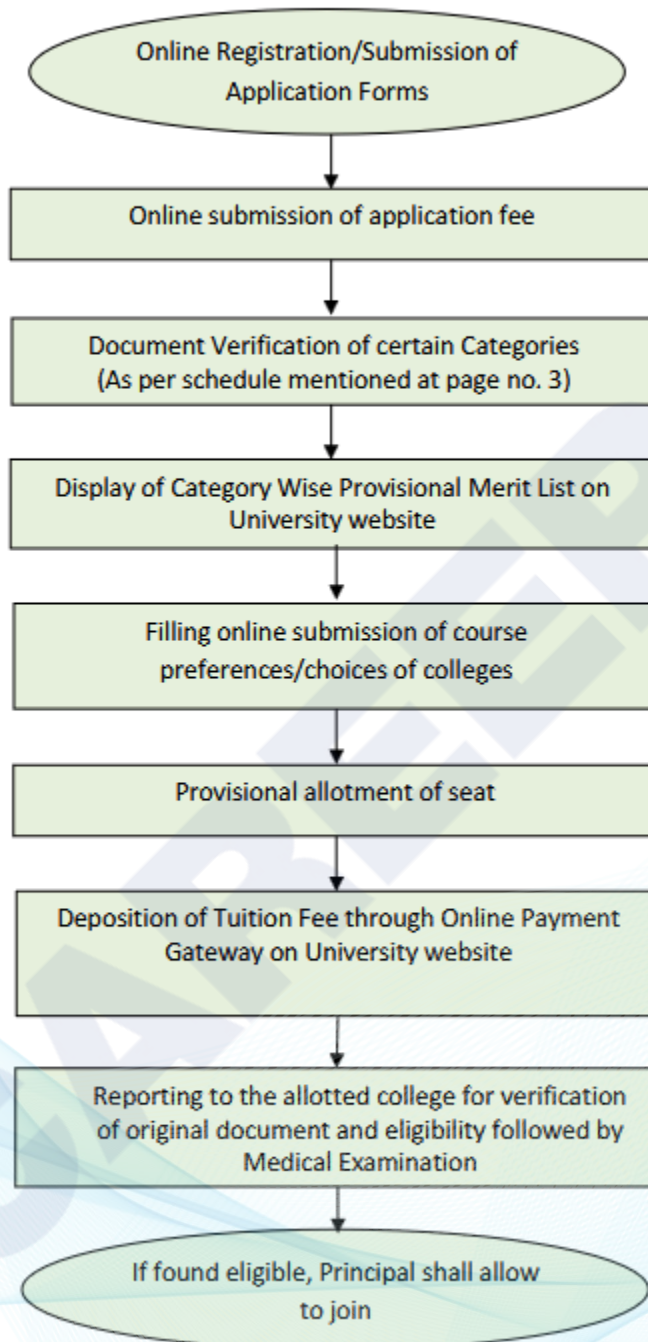
Counselling for admission to MBBS/BDS, session 2024 was conducted online followed by Physical reporting of the candidates to allotted colleges. During online counseling, candidates will fill online counselling forms.

The counselling process is open to only those candidates who are included in the state merit list. To participate in the counselling process, merit list candidates need to fill the counselling form and then exercise choice filling. The allotment of seats will be based on both the merit rank of the candidate and also choices opted for admission. Candidates who are allotted seats will have to report at the allotted institute within the given schedule to complete the admission process.

Document Checklist Counselling

- ❖ Pass certificate, mark sheets of Class 10 and 10+2
- ❖ Matric (or Class 10 certificate) as proof of Date of Birth
- ❖ NEET admit card and result/score card
- ❖ Printout of Online application/registration form
- ❖ Domicile certificate
- ❖ Character certificate
- ❖ Category certificate, as applicable
- ❖ Valid ID proof
- ❖ Punjab residence certificate
- ❖ Passport size photographs
- ❖ Gap certificate (if applicable)
- ❖ Copy of Bank Challan form

Reservation Criteria

Candidates who are natives of Punjab are eligible for reservation as per the category they belong to. For example, seats up to the tune of 25% are reserved for SC candidates in government and government-aided institutes.
