Introduction to EBook

In this EBook, we will discuss all the details of a LLB (Bachelor of Legislative Law) degree. Students will get to know about various specialisations in the field of law, eligibility criteria, top entrance examinations, admission procedure, scope and opportunities, and top recruiters of some popular LLB specialisations. In the end, we will also list the top law institutes in various states of India.



Overview

LLB full form is Bachelor of Legislative Law is an undergraduate degree programme in the field of [law](#). The course equips the students with knowledge about the legal procedures and practices. LLB can be pursued in two formats: three-year [LLB](#) or five-year integrated LLB. Some of the subjects that are taught in the LLB course and form the core part of the syllabus are Law of Contract, Law of Torts, and Constitutional Law.

Students can pursue various career options after completing the LLB degree such as [Corporate Lawyer](#), Legal Advisor, [Family Lawyer](#), Civil Lawyer, and Criminal Lawyer. The field of law includes various specialised areas, some of the popular ones are; Civil Rights Law, Tax Law, Criminal Law, and Corporate Law.

To get admission to their desired law school, students should follow the course details and also meet the eligibility requirements. They need to clear their 10+2 education with a minimum required aggregate score. Some colleges require the students to score 50 per cent aggregate marks while other colleges require only 45 per cent, the aggregate percentage may vary from one institution to another, so candidates should check the official website of the college to know all the course details.

The entrance examinations that the candidates must clear to get admission to the LLB degree courses are CLAT, LSAT, AILET, and MHT CET. The top colleges offering courses in the field of Law are NLSIU Bangalore, NLU Delhi, SLS Pune, and NLU Hyderabad. Applicants should go through the website of the aforementioned colleges to know all the course details.



Admission

Students should follow the admission requirements of the LLB degree programme carefully. The admission and eligibility details vary depending on the institutes therefore, the candidates should check the websites of these colleges regularly for the updates. They can also check the LLB programme brochure of these colleges to know all the details. In this section of the EBook we will discuss the admission procedure and eligibility requirements of some leading law schools in different states of India.

Eligibility Criteria

Since there are many private and public law schools in India, the eligibility criteria may vary from one institute to another. Generally, students should have completed their higher education (10+2) and have scored at least 50 per cent aggregate score to fulfil the basic eligibility requirements. Listed below are the eligibility requirements of the top institutes in India.

- ❖ Students who have completed their 10+2 in any stream, be it [science](#), [commerce](#), or [humanities](#), are eligible to apply for the LLB course. Applicants who have completed their graduation and are awaiting the result are also eligible for the LLB degree.
- ❖ Candidates should score at least 50 per cent in their last qualifying examination, some colleges may also provide admission if they have scored 45 per cent aggregate score.
- ❖ Some colleges also provide 5 per cent relaxation in the aggregate score for the candidates belonging to the reserved categories such as OBC, SC and ST.

Admission Procedure

After meeting the eligibility requirements of the course, students can apply for the LLB degree programme. Most of the law schools provide admissions based on the entrance examinations, while a few colleges may also focus more on the interview part. Listed below are the admission details of the top law schools in India.

- ❖ Generally, the admissions to the Law courses in India are based on the entrance examinations such as CLAT, LSAT, MHT CET, and AILET. Every year, law schools release the cutoff for various law courses. Candidates should meet the cutoff score of their desired institute to fulfil the admission requirements.
- ❖ Since law is a field that requires excellent communication and decision making skills, many law schools lay emphasis on the interview part. Some colleges may also conduct group discussions to test the debate skills of the candidates.
- ❖ Once they have cleared the required admission tests, candidates are eligible for admission to the LLB course.
- ❖ They should submit the necessary documents along with the specified course fees to conclude the admission process.



Entrance Exams

There are many well-renowned national-level law entrance examinations such as CLAT, LSAT, and AILET. Many law colleges also conduct their entrance examinations such as SLAT and PU UG Law entrance examinations. Some of the popular state-level entrance examinations are KLEE and TS LAW CET exam. In this section, we will discuss the details of the top law entrance examinations in India.

CLAT: Common Law Admission Test or CLAT is one of the most popular national-level law entrance examinations conducted by the Consortium of NLUs. CLAT scores are accepted by many top law schools in India such as the NLUs for admissions to the undergraduate law courses.

The graduates can work as either a government or a private attorney. They can work at various workplaces such as a corporation, law firms, IT and administrative services. In this section, we will discuss what is the scope of the law field and what are the opportunities available for the aspirants after getting a law degree.

What after LLB?

After completing the LLB course students can work at a law firm or they can also practise law independently. Since law plays a very important role in every industry, the scope of qualified law professionals is also on the rise. After completing the course, they can work in a corporate firm or they can also start their own law firm and practice independently. They can also pursue higher education in degrees such as [LLM](#) in their desired specialisation. Students can even pursue a [Ph.D in Law](#) if they are interested in becoming a professor at a college or a university.

Career Options after LLB

Since there are various specialisations in the field of law, the career options also vary from one specialisation to another. In this section, we will discuss some of the popular career options in the field of law.

[Government Lawyer](#): Government Lawyers are professionals who work for a government. They provide legal advice to the government ministers and help them in taking legal solutions for the country. They are responsible for pursuing criminal offences, making new legal policies and updating the existing ones.

[Corporate Lawyer](#): Corporate Lawyers are professionals who work in a company and handle its legal affairs. They also provide guidance to the board of directors to make firm and administrative decisions for the company.

[Legal Advisor](#): Legal Advisors are professionals who provide legal advice to the corporations and its employees. They are responsible for overseeing the contracts, drafting, damage claims, resolving disputes, and offering cost-effective legal advice.
