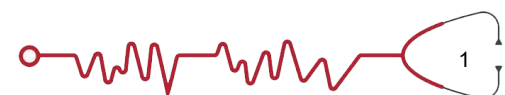


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Introduction to EBook

This EBook on MBBS will help the students understand in detail about the MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery) degree. We will discuss in detail about the eligibility criteria, admission procedure, and entrance examinations required to pursue an MBBS degree. 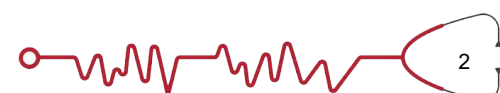


Overview

The MBBS or Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery is an undergraduate degree in the field of medicine and surgery. The duration of an MBBS degree is generally five and a half years; four and a half years of course work and one year of compulsory internship. In the MBBS degree programme, students learn about several topics related to the medical field, such as Fundamentals of Diseases and Treatment, Basic Haematology, Cell Biology and Molecular Medicine.

The top colleges offering the MBBS course in India are AIIMS Delhi, CMC Vellore, AIIMS Jodhpur, and MSU Baroda. To be eligible for the MBBS degree, students should successfully clear their 10+2 grade in the [medical](#) stream with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English being the compulsory subjects. The admission procedure typically involves an entrance examination such as NEET UG. Students must clear the entrance examinations and meet the required cutoff to be eligible for admission. They can then appear for the counselling session and choose the college based on their cutoff score.

Popular career options after an MBBS degree are Doctor, Medical Officers, Surgeon, General Physician, and Paediatrician. They can choose the career options on the basis of their future goals and aspirations. The average salary of a Doctor in India is Rs. 7.9 LPA depending on their experience and qualifications. Candidates can also opt for higher education in degrees such as [MD](#) (Doctor of Medicine) and choose their desired specialisation after completing their MBBS degree.



Admission

The admission requirements of an MBBS course remain almost identical for every medical Institute in India, but candidates should check the website of the college to understand the admission requirements in detail. For further information about the course, students should check the official website to understand the admission procedure in detail. In this section, we will discuss the eligibility criteria and admission procedure for the MBBS degree in detail.

Eligibility Criteria

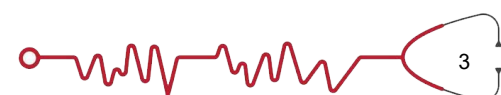
The eligibility criteria are very important for students willing to pursue the MBBS degree. There are many medical schools, therefore, the eligibility criteria may differ depending on the admission policies of the institute. Students are advised to go through the official website of the college to know the eligibility requirements and course details. For the student's reference, we have mentioned below the basic eligibility requirements for an MBBS degree.

- ❖ Many medical schools in India require candidates to have successfully cleared their 10+2 in the science stream with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English being the compulsory subjects. Students who have Biology as an additional subject are also eligible to apply for the MBBS degree.
- ❖ The minimum aggregate marks that the candidates are required to score are generally 60 per cent for the general category, though some colleges may require even higher marks.
- ❖ Candidates belonging to SC/ST or PWBD may get a relaxation of 5-10 per cent in the aggregate score.
- ❖ To register for the NEET UG examination, students should be at least 17 years old, there is no maximum age limit.
- ❖ Every year, medical colleges release the cutoff for admissions to the MBBS course. Students can check the official website to find out the same.
- ❖ Once they clear the entrance examination, students can apply for the counselling session and choose the best possible college based on the cutoff score.

Admission Procedure

After meeting the eligibility requirements of the MBBS course, students can start with the application process. Generally, MBBS admissions are through entrance examinations such as NEET UG. Listed below is the admission procedure for an MBBS degree programme in detail.

- ❖ Many institutes in India offer admissions to the MBBS degree programme based on the marks obtained by them in the entrance examination.



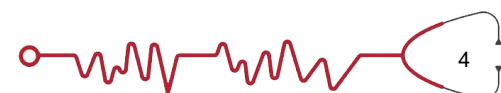
- ❖ Students can apply for the admission procedure either by directly applying for the required entrance examination or by filling the application form.
- ❖ NEET UG is one of the most popular medical entrance examinations for MBBS admissions. Students should successfully clear the entrance examination and meet the cutoff as required by their chosen medical college.
- ❖ The minimum age limit to apply for the admissions is 17 years, while there is no maximum age limit.
- ❖ Once they have cleared the entrance examination, students should be eligible for the admission procedure.
- ❖ They should then pay the required course fees along with the application fee and submit the required official documents such as Aadhar card, class 10th and 12th marksheet, exit/migration certificate, and birth certificate. Students should check the admission tab of the college's website or programme brochure to know the official documents required.

Entrance Exams

Whilst many medical institutes in India may conduct their own entrance examinations for providing admissions to the MBBS degree, NEET UG continues to be the most popular and important undergraduate medical entrance examination. A number of leading medical institutes in India accept the scores of the NEET UG exam for admissions.

NEET UG: National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test or NEET UG is an undergraduate medical entrance examination for MBBS degree. The exam is conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) once a year in offline mode.

Career Options after MBBS

Doctor: Doctors are medical professionals who work at a hospital or a clinic and provide the students with therapeutic, surgical and medical care. They are also responsible for diagnosing, examining, and prescribing relevant medicines to the patients.

Surgeon: Surgeons are professionals who are responsible for diagnosing and treating medical illnesses that may require surgery. They are responsible for all stages of a surgery and ensuring that the surgery takes place as smoothly as possible without any complications.

General Physician: Physicians are professionals who are responsible for examining patients, finding out the cause, and prescribing medical tests if required. Physicians can work at a variety of settings such as public health organisations, medical labs at schools and colleges, hospitals, and clinics.

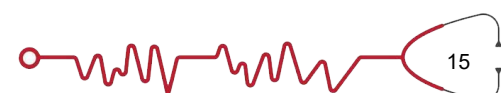
