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# 1.1 OVERVIEW



The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) is one of the most prestigious medical institutions in India. It was established with the objective of providing excellence in medical education, high-quality patient care, and advanced medical research. AIIMS sets benchmarks for medical institutions across the country and plays a vital role in strengthening India's healthcare system.

The first AIIMS was established in 1956 in New Delhi through an Act of Parliament. The vision was to create a medical institution that would combine education, research, and clinical practice under one roof. Due to its success and growing healthcare needs, the Government of India later expanded the AIIMS model by establishing multiple AIIMS institutions in different states.

At present, AIIMS functions as a network of autonomous public medical colleges and hospitals under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. All AIIMS institutes follow uniform academic standards, admission procedures, and governance policies to ensure consistent quality across the country.

## KEY CHARACTERISTICS OF AIIMS

AIIMS is distinguished from other medical colleges by the following core characteristics:

- **Autonomous Status:** AIIMS institutes have academic and administrative autonomy, allowing them to maintain high educational standards and adopt modern teaching methods.
- **Merit-Based Admissions:** Admission to AIIMS is highly competitive and strictly merit-based, primarily through national-level entrance examinations.
- **Integrated Teaching and Clinical Training:** Students receive hands-on clinical exposure from early years through AIIMS hospitals, which handle a large and diverse patient load.
- **Strong Research Focus:** AIIMS promotes medical research, innovation, and evidence-based practice, encouraging students to participate in research activities.
- **Highly Qualified Faculty:** AIIMS has experienced and renowned faculty members who are leaders in their respective medical fields.

## 1.2 HISTORY OF AIIMS

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) was conceived soon after India's independence, with the goal of creating a medical institution that could set national standards in medical education, research, and healthcare. The foundation stone of AIIMS was laid in 1952, during the tenure of Rajkumari Amrit Kaur, India's first Health Minister, who played a key role in shaping India's public health system.

### EXPANSION OF AIIMS ACROSS INDIA

To address regional inequalities in access to quality healthcare and medical education, the Government of India launched the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). Although announced in 2003, the programme was officially launched in 2006. Its main objective was to establish AIIMS-like institutions in underserved regions and upgrade existing government medical colleges.

Under PMSSY, the expansion of AIIMS took place in multiple phases:

- **Phase I (2006):** Six new AIIMS were announced in Patna, Raipur, Bhubaneswar, Bhopal, Jodhpur, and Rishikesh. These institutes marked the beginning of AIIMS as a national network rather than a single institution.
- **Phase II (2013):** AIIMS Raebareli was established through a government notification.
- **Phase III:** Several existing medical colleges, especially in Uttar Pradesh, were upgraded to super-specialty institutions on the lines of AIIMS, strengthening tertiary healthcare capacity.
- **Phase IV (2014):** Four more AIIMS were announced in Andhra Pradesh (Mangalagiri), Maharashtra (Nagpur), Uttar Pradesh (Gorakhpur), and West Bengal (Kalyani), most of which became operational between 2018 and 2019.
- **Phase V (2015):** Seven additional AIIMS were approved in Jammu & Kashmir (Jammu and Awantipora), Assam (Guwahati), Punjab (Bathinda), Himachal Pradesh (Bilaspur), Tamil Nadu (Madurai), and Bihar (Darbhanga). These institutes became operational in phases between 2019 and 2024.
- **Phase VI (2017):** AIIMS were announced for Jharkhand (Deoghar) and Gujarat (Rajkot).
- **Phase VII (2017):** AIIMS Bibinagar (Telangana) was approved and began operations in 2019.
- **Phase VIII (2019):** AIIMS Rewari (Haryana) was announced and later approved.

- AIIMS New Delhi has held the #1 NIRF Medical ranking from 2023–2025 with a very high score (91.8), clearly separating it from all other AIIMS.
- Mid-tier AIIMS are converging, as Rishikesh, Bhopal, and Raipur improve rankings, while clustered scores between ranks 13–31 cause small gains to trigger jumps.
- Several newer AIIMS remain unranked, indicating that they are still in early stages of academic and institutional development.



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# 3.1 STEP-BY-STEP ADMISSION PROCESS

The admission process for MBBS at AIIMS is centralized and merit-based, ensuring equal opportunities for students across the country. Admission is conducted through **NEET-UG**, followed by online counselling by the **Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)**. The steps below explain how students can secure an MBBS seat in AIIMS.



## 3.2 NEET UG

**NEET-UG (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test – Undergraduate)** is a national-level medical entrance examination conducted annually by the **National Testing Agency (NTA)**. It is the mandatory exam for admission to MBBS, BDS (Bachelor of Dental Surgery), and other undergraduate medical courses, including all AIIMS institutes across India. NEET-UG serves as the single gateway for medical admissions in government and private medical colleges.

NEET-UG evaluates candidates on Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (Botany & Zoology) based on the Class 11 and 12 syllabus prescribed by NCERT. The exam is designed to test a student's conceptual understanding, application skills, and scientific aptitude, which are essential for pursuing a career in medicine.

Conducted once a year, NEET-UG is an offline (pen-and-paper) exam consisting of multiple-choice questions (MCQs). Admission to AIIMS and other medical colleges is based on the NEET score and All India Rank (AIR), followed by centralized counselling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC).

To secure admission to top institutions like AIIMS, candidates must achieve a high NEET-UG score, as the exam is highly competitive. Aspirants should regularly check official updates related to exam dates, eligibility criteria, syllabus, and counselling process to stay informed.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

#### ✓ Educational Qualification

- Must have passed Class 12 (10+2) or equivalent from a recognised board.
- Mandatory subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English.
- Students from open schools or state boards are also eligible if the required subjects were studied.

#### ✓ Minimum Marks:

- General/Unreserved: Minimum 50% aggregate in PCB.
- OBC/SC/ST/PwD: Minimum 40% aggregate in PCB..

#### ✓ Age Criteria

- Minimum age: Must be at least 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- No upper age limit is specified; candidates under NTA guidelines can apply regardless of age.

#### ✓ Nationality


- Indian citizens, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) and foreign nationals are eligible to apply

#### ✓ Attempt Limit

- No limit on the number of attempts; candidates can appear for NEET as many times as they wish if they meet eligibility.


## ADMISSION FUNNEL 2025

The admission funnel for NEET UG, starting from the number of students who appeared for the NEET exam to the final AIIMS MBBS seats available. It shows that out of over 22 lakh candidates who appeared for NEET, only **0.1%**, i.e. **2,257**, ultimately secured **AIIMS MBBS seats** after passing through successive qualifying and counselling stages.

Between 2021 and 2025, **registrations increased by 40.9%**, **appearances by 43.1%**, and **qualified candidates by 42.2%**, indicating a sharp rise in participation and sustained intensification of competition over the five-year period.




## GENDER TREND

From 2021–2025, **female candidates** consistently achieved higher qualification efficiency (**56–58%**) **than males (~55%)**, with stable ratios over time, while male conversion rates dipped slightly despite rising participation, highlighting stronger and more resilient female performance overall.



## 3.4 NEET UG COUNSELLING FOR AIIMS

Admission to MBBS seats in AIIMS is conducted exclusively through NEET-UG counselling, replacing the earlier AIIMS MBBS entrance exam. The counselling process is centralised, transparent, and merit-based, and is conducted by the **Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)** under the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Government of India.

### COUNSELLING AUTHORITY & SEAT ALLOCATION

- **Conducting Body:** Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)
- **Mode:** Online (centralised counselling)
- **Quota Covered:**
  - 100% MBBS seats of all AIIMS institutions are filled through MCC counselling.
- **Colleges Covered:**
  - All AIIMS institutions across India offering MBBS

Seat allotment is strictly based on NEET-UG rank, category, reservation norms, and choices filled by candidates.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR AIIMS COUNSELLING VIA NEET-UG

- Qualified NEET-UG with the required cutoff percentile
- Completed Class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English
- Must meet age and nationality criteria as prescribed for NEET-UG
- Eligible candidates must register separately on the MCC portal

## 3.5 RESERVATION POLICY AT AIIMS

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) follows the Government of India's reservation policy for admission to MBBS and other courses. As AIIMS is a central institution and an Institute of National Importance (INI), reservations are applied uniformly across all AIIMS campuses through NEET-UG counselling conducted by MCC. The objective is to ensure equitable access to medical education for students from socially and economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

### RESERVATION CATEGORIES AT AIIMS (MBBS)

AIIMS provides reservation under the following categories:

Category	Reservation Percentage
Scheduled Castes (SC)	15%
Scheduled Tribes (ST)	7.5%
Other Backward Classes – Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL)	27%

Unreserved / General (UR)	Remaining seats

\*PwBD reservation is horizontal, meaning it cuts across all categories (UR, SC, ST, OBC, EWS).

### CERTIFICATES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To claim reservation at AIIMS, candidates must submit:

- SC/ST Certificate issued by a competent authority
- OBC-NCL Certificate (Non-Creamy Layer, valid for the current financial year)
- EWS Certificate as per Government of India format
- PwBD Certificate issued by a designated disability assessment board

! *Invalid or outdated certificates can lead to cancellation of candidature.*

### RESERVATION DURING NEET-UG COUNSELLING

- Category-wise cut-offs are different and usually lower than General category

## 4.2 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR AIIMS MBBS STUDENTS

Students admitted to the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) through NEET benefit from highly subsidized tuition because AIIMS institutions are centrally funded public medical colleges supported by the Government of India to ensure affordable medical education and strengthen the national healthcare workforce. However, additional scholarships and financial assistance are available from institutional, government, research, and private sources. This overview summarizes the most reliable options.

### 1. AIIMS INSTITUTIONAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT

#### Merit-cum-Means Scholarships

Most AIIMS campuses provide financial assistance based on:

- Academic performance
- Demonstrated financial need

Support may include partial tuition waivers or annual grants. Continuation usually depends on maintaining satisfactory academic progress.

#### Additional Institutional Aid

AIIMS campuses may also offer:

- Fee concessions or freeships for economically weaker students
- Alumni/endowment scholarships
- Emergency student welfare funds

Availability varies by AIIMS campus, so students should confirm through the institute's academic or student affairs office.

### 2. CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

#### Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for College Students

This national scholarship supports meritorious Class 12 graduates from lower-income families.

Key features:

- Annual financial assistance during undergraduate study
- Applicable to AIIMS MBBS students if eligibility criteria are met
- Applications through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP)

#### Post-Matric Scholarships (Category-Based)

Government scholarships exist for students from specific categories, including:

- SC/ST
- OBC
- Minority communities
- Economically weaker sections (EWS)

These typically cover tuition support and maintenance allowances.

### 3. RESEARCH FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

#### CMR Short-Term Studentship (STS)

A major national research program for MBBS students:

- Competitive selection process
- Research project under faculty supervision
- Stipend provided upon successful completion
- Valuable academic and career development experience

This is one of the most recognized research funding avenues for medical students in India.

### 4. PRIVATE AND FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

AIIMS students are eligible for several external scholarships, including:

- **Tata Trusts Medical Scholarship** — Need-based financial support for healthcare education
- **Reliance Foundation Undergraduate Scholarship** — Merit-cum-means scholarship across disciplines
- **Infosys STEM Stars Scholarship** — Support for high-performing female STEM students
- **LIC Golden Jubilee Scholarship** — Merit-cum-means financial assistance for higher education

Eligibility criteria, deadlines, and award amounts vary annually.

### 5. APPLICATION PATHWAYS

Students typically apply through:

- National Scholarship Portal (central government schemes)
- AIIMS institutional scholarship channels
- State government scholarship portals
- Official websites of private trusts and foundations

Timely application and documentation are essential.

# 4.3 AIIMS MBBS STIPEND & JUNIOR RESIDENT SALARY

At AIIMS (All India Institute of Medical Sciences), MBBS students do not receive a salary during the academic course. Financial compensation begins only during the mandatory internship and later in clinical service roles such as Junior Residency. Pay structures follow Central Government norms (7th Central Pay Commission).

## 1. MBBS INTERNSHIP STIPEND (COMPULSORY ROTATING INTERNSHIP)

During the one-year internship after final MBBS exams, interns work full-time across hospital departments and receive a monthly stipend.

### Typical stipend range:

- ₹26,000 – ₹30,000 per month (approx.)
- Exact amount varies slightly by AIIMS campus and periodic revisions.

### Key points:

- This is a training stipend, not a formal salary.
- Provided only during the internship year.
- Intended mainly to cover living expenses while gaining clinical experience.

## 2. JUNIOR RESIDENT (JR) SALARY AT AIIMS

After internship and medical registration, MBBS graduates may join AIIMS as Junior Residents (non-academic) — contractual clinical posts involving patient care, ward duties, emergency work, and sometimes teaching.

### Official Pay Structure (7th CPC)

- **Pay Level:** Level 10
- **Basic Pay:** ₹56,100/month
- **Plus allowances:**
  - Dearness Allowance (DA)
  - House Rent Allowance (HRA) or hostel accommodation
  - Transport Allowance
  - Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA) where applicable

### Estimated Take-Home Salary

- Typically about ₹80,000 – ₹1,10,000/month after allowances and deductions.
- Variation depends on:
  - City classification (HRA rates)
  - Institute-specific policies
  - Accommodation provided vs rented housing.

### Important nuance:

- JR posts are usually contractual (often 6-month terms, extendable) rather than permanent government jobs.


M.B.B.S Median Salary Trend (in Rs.)






M.B.B.S Median Salary Trend (in Rs.)






M.B.B.S Median Salary Trend (in Rs.)






